
NTSBC Active Deacons

Overview of Ephesians 5:15-21

Live in God's wisdom, understand God's will and make the most of every opportunity you have to glorify God by: rejecting foolishness and drunkenness while being filled with The Holy Spirit, praising and giving thanks to God for everything in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

1. We must serve each other in <u>awe</u> of Jesus Christ our Lord. "²¹ submitting to one another in the fear of Christ." *Ephesians 5:21 (CSB)*

"⁵ Adopt the same attitude as that of Christ Jesus, ⁶ who, existing in the form of God, did not consider equality with God as something to be exploited. ⁷ Instead he emptied himself by assuming the form of a servant, taking on the likeness of humanity. And when he had come as a man, ⁸ he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death—even to death on a cross." *Philippians 2:5-8 (CSB)*

Jesus said, "whoever is greatest among you should become like the youngest, and whoever leads, like the one serving. ²⁷ For who is greater, the one at the table or the one serving? Isn't it the one at the table? But I am among you as the one who serves."

Luke 22:26-27 (CSB)

2. Wives serve as <u>examples</u> of the church's love for Jesus. "²² Wives, submit' to your husbands <u>as to the Lord</u>, ²³ <u>because the husband is the head of the wife as Christ is the head of the church.</u> He is the Savior of the body. ²⁴ Now as the church submits to Christ, so also wives are to submit to their husbands in everything."

"23 Whatever you do, do it from the heart, as something done for the Lord and not for people, 24 knowing that you will receive the reward of an inheritance from the Lord. You serve the Lord Christ."

Colossians 3:23-24 (CSB)

"²⁵ Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself for her ²⁶ to make her holy, cleansing her with the washing of water by the word. ²⁷ He did this to present the church to himself in splendor, without spot or wrinkle or anything like that, but holy and blameless. ²⁸ In the same way, husbands are to love their wives as their own bodies. He who loves his wife loves himself. ²⁹ For no one ever hates his own flesh but provides and cares for it, just as Christ does for the church, ³⁰ since we are members of his body. ³¹ For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two will become one flesh. ³² This mystery is profound, but Lam talking about Christ and the church. ³³ To sum up, each one of you is to love his wife as himself, and the wife is to respect her husband."
