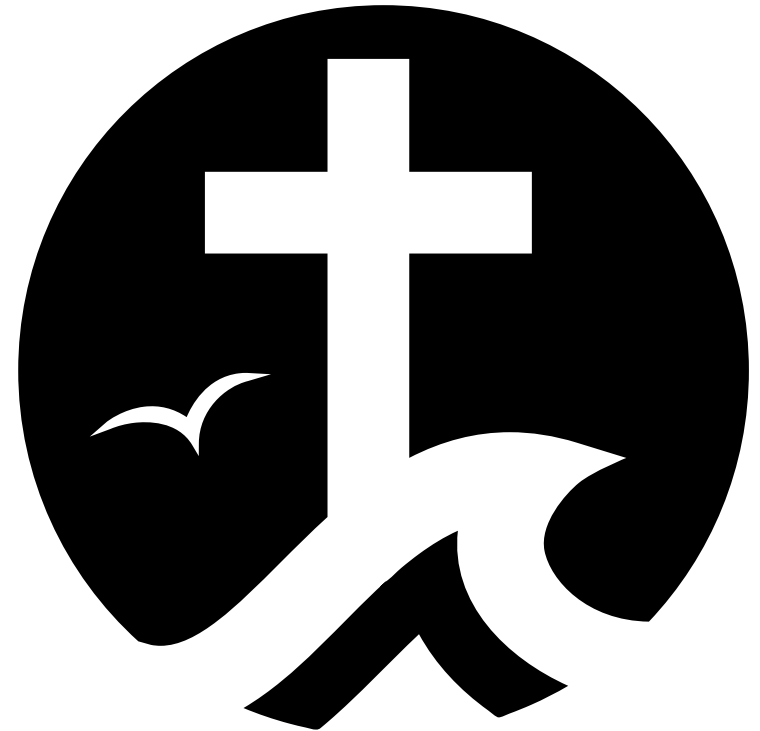

Part 13 Jesus & His Church; *our model for marriage*

Overview of Ephesians 5:15-21

Live in God's wisdom, understand God's will and make the most of every opportunity you have to glorify God by: rejecting foolishness and drunkenness while being filled with The Holy Spirit, praising and giving thanks to God for everything in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

1. We must serve each other in awe of Jesus Christ our Lord.

²¹submitting to one another in the fear of Christ." *Ephesians 5:21 (CSB)*

⁵Adopt the same attitude as that of Christ Jesus, ⁶who, existing in the form of God, did not consider equality with God as something to be exploited. ⁷Instead he emptied himself by assuming the form of a servant, taking on the likeness of humanity. And when he had come as a man, ⁸he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death—even to death on a cross." *Philippians 2:5-8 (CSB)*

Jesus said, "whoever is greatest among you should become like the youngest, and whoever leads, like the one serving. ²⁷For who is greater, the one at the table or the one serving? Isn't it the one at the table? But I am among you as the one who serves."

Luke 22:26-27 (CSB)

2. Wives serve as examples of the church's love for Jesus.

²²Wives, submit to your husbands as to the Lord, ²³because the husband is the head of the wife as Christ is the head of the church. He is the Savior of the body. ²⁴Now as the church submits to Christ, so also wives are to submit to their husbands in everything."

Ephesians 5:22-24 (CSB)

²³Whatever you do, do it from the heart, as something done for the Lord and not for people, ²⁴knowing that you will receive the reward of an inheritance from the Lord. You serve the Lord Christ."

Colossians 3:23-24 (CSB)

²⁴He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree; so that, having died to sins, we might live for righteousness. By his wounds you have been healed. *Isaiah 53:5* ²⁵For you were like sheep going astray, *Isaiah 53:6* but

you have now returned to the Shepherd and Overseer of your souls.

¹ In the same way, wives, submit yourselves to your own husbands so that, even if some disobey the word, they may be won over without a word by the way their wives live ²when they observe your pure reverent lives." *1 Peter 2:24–25, 3:1-2 (CSB)*

3. Husbands serve as examples of Jesus' love for His Church.

²⁵Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself for her ²⁶to make her holy, cleansing her with the washing of water by the word. ²⁷He did this to present the church to himself in splendor, without spot or wrinkle or anything like that, but holy and blameless. ²⁸In the same way, husbands are to love their wives as their own bodies. He who loves his wife loves himself. ²⁹For no one ever hates his own flesh but provides and cares for it, just as Christ does for the church, ³⁰since we are members of his body. ³¹For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two will become one flesh. ³²This mystery is profound, but I am talking about Christ and the church. ³³To sum up, each one of you is to love his wife as himself, and the wife is to respect her husband." *Ephesians 5:25-33 (CSB)*

- Jesus Sanctified the church by sacrificing His life on the cross.

 - ❖ The husband is to Demonstrate Spiritual Leadership to his wife.
