
#### NTSBC Active Deacons

## Part 14 God's plan for His family

1. Children, prove your faith in God by obeying your parents. "1Children, obey your parents in the Lord, <u>because this is right</u>." *Ephesians 6:1 (CSB)* 

"17 Then the Lord said, "Should I hide what I am about to do from Abraham? 18 Abraham is to become a great and powerful nation, and all the nations of the earth will be blessed through him. 19 For I have chosen him so that he will command his children and his house after him to keep the way of the Lord by doing what is right and just. This is how the Lord will fulfill to Abraham what he promised him."

Genesis 18:17-19 (CSB)

"20 My son, keep your father's command, and don't reject your mother's teaching. 21 Always bind them to your heart; tie them around your neck. 22 When you walk here and there, they will guide you; when you lie down, they will watch over you; when you wake up, they will talk to you. 23 For a command is a lamp, teaching is a light, and corrective discipline is the way to life." *Proverbs 6:20-23 (CSB)* 

2. Children, verify your love for God by honoring your parents. "<sup>2</sup> Honor your father and mother, which is the first commandment with a promise, <sup>3</sup> so that it may go well with you and that you may have a long life in the land. Exodus 20:12 Ephesians 6:2-3 (CSB)

"20 Children, obey your parents in everything, <u>for this pleases the Lord</u>." *Colossians 3:20 (CSB)* 

"27 They/the Jews/ did not know he was speaking to them about the Father. <sup>28</sup> So Jesus said to them, "When you lift up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am he, and that I do nothing on my own. But just as the Father taught me, I say these things. <sup>29</sup> The one who sent me is with me. He has not left me alone, because I always do what pleases him."

John 8:27-29 (CSB)

"1Then Jesus was approached by Pharisees and scribes from Jerusalem, who asked, <sup>2</sup> "Why do your disciples break the tradition of the elders? For they don't wash their hands when they eat." <sup>3</sup> He answered them, "Why do you break God's commandment because of your tradition? <sup>4</sup> For God said: Honor your father and your mother; and, Whoever speaks evil of father or mother must be put to death. <sup>5</sup> But you say, 'Whoever tells his father or mother, "Whatever benefit you might have received from me is a gift committed to the temple," <sup>6</sup> he does not have to honor his father.' In this way, you have nullified the word of God because of your tradition. <sup>7</sup> Hypocrites! Isaiah prophesied correctly about you when he said: <sup>8</sup> This people honors me with their lips, but their heart is far from me. <sup>9</sup> They worship me in vain, teaching as doctrines human commands." Isaiah 29:13

3. Father's submit to The Lord and bless your children.

"4 Fathers, don't stir up anger in your children, but bring them up in the training and instruction of the Lord." Ephesians 6:4 (CSB)

"6 <u>Train up a child in the way he should go</u>: And when he is old, he will not depart from it." *Proverbs 22:6 (KJV)* 

"<sup>4</sup> Listen, Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one." Love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength. <sup>6</sup> These words that I am giving you today are to be in your heart. <sup>7</sup> Repeat them to your children. Talk about them when you sit in your house and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. <sup>8</sup> Bind them as a sign on your hand and let them be a symbol on your forehead. <sup>9</sup> Write them on the doorposts of your house and on your city gates."

Deuteronomy 6:4-9 (CSB)
