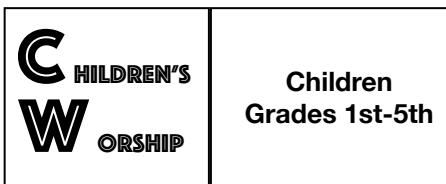

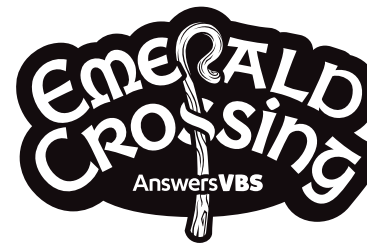

When Life Gets Tough

1. Don't Be Ashamed to Publicly Call on Jesus.

“. . . ²¹When Jesus had crossed over again by boat to the other side, a large crowd gathered around him while he was by the sea. ²²One of the synagogue leaders, named Jairus, came, and when he saw Jesus, he fell at his feet. . . .” *Mark 5:21-22 (CSB)*

“. . . everyone who will acknowledge me before others, I will also acknowledge him before my Father in heaven. ³³But whoever denies me before others, I will also deny him before my Father in heaven. ³⁴Don't assume that I came to bring peace on the earth. I did not come to bring peace, but a sword.” *Matthew 10:32-34 (CSB)*

2. Don't be afraid to ask Jesus for the impossible.

²³and begged him earnestly, “My little daughter is dying. Come and lay your hands on her so that she can get well and live.” ²⁴So Jesus went with him and a large crowd was following and pressing against him. . . .” *Mark 5:23-24 (CSB)*

¹If I speak human or angelic tongues but do not have love, I am a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal. ²If I have the gift of prophecy and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have all faith so that I can move mountains but do not have love, I am nothing. ³And if I give away all my possessions, and if I give over my body in order to boast but do not have love, I gain nothing.” *1 Corinthians 13:1-3 (CSB)*

3. Don't allow circumstances to Discourage you.

³⁵While he was still speaking, people came from the synagogue leader's house and said, “Your daughter is dead. Why bother the teacher anymore?” ³⁶When Jesus overheard what was said, he told the synagogue leader, “Don't be afraid. Only believe.”” *Mark 5:35-36 (CSB)*

²⁵Now a woman suffering from bleeding for twelve years ²⁶had endured much under many doctors. She had spent everything she had and was not helped at all. On the contrary, she became worse. ²⁷Having heard about Jesus, she came up behind him in the crowd and touched

his clothing. ²⁸For she said, “If I just touch his clothes, I'll be made well.” ²⁹Instantly her flow of blood ceased, and she sensed in her body that she was healed of her affliction. ³⁰Immediately Jesus realized that power had gone out from him. He turned around in the crowd and said, “Who touched my clothes?” ³¹His disciples said to him, “You see the crowd pressing against you, and yet you say, ‘Who touched me?’” ³²But he was looking around to see who had done this. ³³The woman, with fear and trembling, knowing what had happened to her, came and fell down before him, and told him the whole truth. ³⁴“Daughter,” he said to her, “your faith has saved you. Go in peace and be healed from your affliction.”

Mark 5:25-34 (CSB)

4. Don't let what Others think Dictate your Faith.

³⁷He did not let anyone accompany him except Peter, James, and John, James's brother. ³⁸They came to the leader's house, and he saw a commotion—people weeping and wailing loudly. ³⁹He went in and said to them, “Why are you making a commotion and weeping? The child is not dead but asleep.” ⁴⁰They laughed at him, but he put them all outside. He took the child's father, mother, and those who were with him, and entered the place where the child was. ⁴¹Then he took the child by the hand and said to her, *Talitha koum*” (which is translated, “Little girl, I say to you, get up”). ⁴²Immediately the girl got up and began to walk. (She was twelve years old.) At this they were utterly astounded. ⁴³Then he gave them strict orders that no one should know about this and told them to give her something to eat.”

Mark 5:37-43 (CSB)
