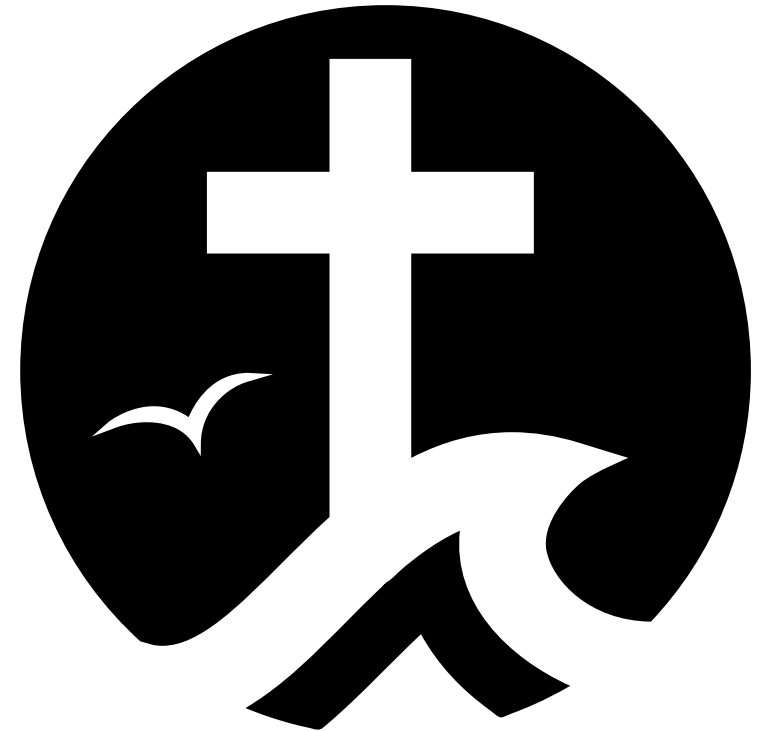

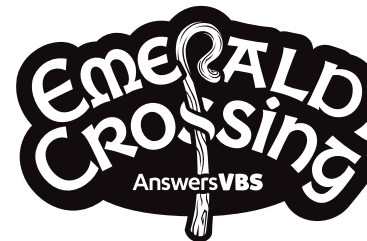

Philippians: Live Under The Authority of Christ

Part 4 Respond to God's Goodness

1. Respond to God's Goodness with Faithful **Obedience**.

"¹²Therefore, my dear friends, just as you have always obeyed, so now, not only in my presence but even more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling." Philippians 2:12 (CSB)

"¹⁰ . . . the death he (*Jesus*) died, he died to sin once for all time; but the life he lives, he lives to God. ¹¹ So, you too consider yourselves dead to sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus.

"¹²Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body, so that you obey its desires. ¹³And do not offer any parts of it to sin as weapons for unrighteousness. But as those who are alive from the dead, offer yourselves to God, and all the parts of yourselves to God as weapons for righteousness." Romans 6:10-13 (CSB)

"²⁰I have been crucified with Christ, and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me." Galatians 2:20 (CSB)

2. Respond to God's Goodness with Faithful **Fellowship**.

"¹³For it is God who is working in you both to will and to work according to his good purpose. ¹⁴Do everything without grumbling and arguing. ¹⁵so that you may be blameless and pure, children of God who are faultless in a crooked and perverted generation, among whom you shine like stars in the world. ¹⁶by holding firm to the word of life." Philippians 2:13-16 (CSB)

"¹⁵If you love me, you will keep my commands. ¹⁶And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Counselor to be with you forever.

"¹⁷He is the Spirit of truth. The world is unable to receive him because it doesn't see him or know him. But you do know him, because he remains with you and will be in you. ¹⁸"I will not leave you as orphans; I am coming to you. ¹⁹In a little while the world will no longer see me, but you will see me. Because I live, you will live too.

"²⁰On that day you will know that I am in my Father, you are in me, and I am in you. ²¹The one who has my commands and keeps them is the one who loves me. And the one who loves me will be loved by my Father. I also will love him and will reveal myself to him." John 14:15-21 (CSB)

3. Respond to God's Goodness as a Faithful **Witness**.

"Then I can boast in the day of Christ that I didn't run or labor for nothing. ¹⁷But even if I am poured out as a drink offering on the sacrificial service of your faith, I am glad and rejoice with all of you. ¹⁸In the same way you should also be glad and rejoice with me." Philippians 2:16-18 (CSB)

"⁶So when they had come together, they asked him, "Lord, are you restoring the kingdom to Israel at this time?" ⁷He said to them, "It is not for you to know times or periods that the Father has set by his own authority. ⁸But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come on you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." Acts 1:6-8 (CSB)

"¹⁸Jesus came near and said to them, "All authority has been given to me in heaven and on earth. ¹⁹Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰teaching them to observe everything I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age." Matthew 28:18-20 (CSB)
