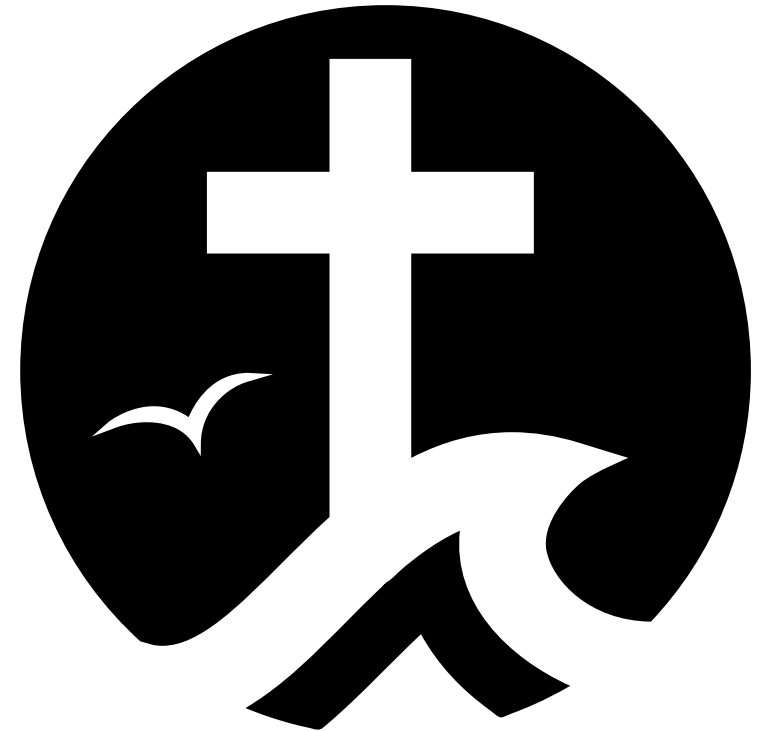

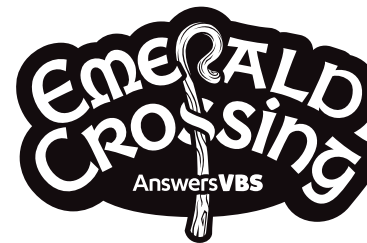

Philippians: Live Under The Authority of Christ

Part 7 The Goal of Our Salvation

1. So we may know Jesus Christ our Lord and Savior.

¹⁰My goal is to know him . . .” *Philippians 3:10 (CSB)*

²⁵At that time Jesus said, “I praise you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because you have hidden these things from the wise and intelligent and revealed them to infants. ²⁶Yes, Father, because this was your good pleasure. ²⁷All things have been entrusted to me by my Father. No one knows the Son except the Father, and no one knows the Father except the Son and anyone to whom the Son desires to reveal him. ²⁸“Come to me, all of you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. ²⁹Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, because I am lowly and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. ³⁰For my yoke is easy and my burden is light.” *Matthew 11:25-30 (CSB)*

2. So we may know the power of Jesus’ resurrection.

¹⁰My goal is to know him and the power of his resurrection . . .” *Philippians 3:10 (CSB)*

¹⁴I am the good shepherd. I know my own, and my own know me, ¹⁵just as the Father knows me, and I know the Father. I lay down my life for the sheep. ¹⁶But I have other sheep that are not from this sheep pen; I must bring them also, and they will listen to my voice. Then there will be one flock, one shepherd. ¹⁷This is why the Father loves me, because I lay down my life so that I may take it up again. ¹⁸No one takes it from me, but I lay it down on my own. I have the right to lay it down, and I have the right to take it up again. I have received this command from my Father.” *John 10:14-18 (CSB)*

¹When I came to you, brothers and sisters, announcing the mystery of God to you, I did not come with brilliance of speech or wisdom.

²I decided to know nothing among you except Jesus Christ and him crucified. ³I came to you in weakness, in fear, and in much trembling. ⁴My speech and my preaching were not with persuasive words of wisdom but with a demonstration of the Spirit’s power, ⁵so that your faith might not be based on human wisdom but on God’s power.” *1 Corinthians 2:1-5 (CSB)*

3. So we may know the fellowship of Jesus’ suffering.

¹⁰My goal is to know Him and the power of His resurrection and the fellowship of his sufferings, being conformed to his death, ¹¹assuming that I will somehow reach the resurrection from among the dead.” *Philippians 3:10-11 (CSB)*

¹What should we say then? Should we continue in sin so that grace may multiply? ²Absolutely not! How can we who died to sin still live in it? ³Or are you unaware that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? ⁴Therefore we were buried with him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, so we too may walk in newness of life. ⁵For if we have been united with him in the likeness of his death, we will certainly also be in the likeness of his resurrection. ⁶For we know that our old self was crucified with him so that the body ruled by sin might be rendered powerless so that we may no longer be enslaved to sin, ⁷since a person who has died is freed from sin. ⁸Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with him, ⁹because we know that Christ, having been raised from the dead, will not die again. Death no longer rules over him. ¹⁰For the death he died, he died to sin once for all time; but the life he lives, he lives to God. ¹¹So, you too consider yourselves dead to sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus.” *Romans 6:1-11 (CSB)*
