(I Point) _____ In The Guide.

7 But everything that was a gain to me, I have considered to be a loss because of Christ. 8 More than that, I also consider everything to be a loss in view of the surpassing value of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. Because of him I have suffered the loss of all things and consider them as dung, so that I may gain Christ (Philippians 3: 7-8 CSB)

- **Time In Conversation with Him**

²Devote yourselves to prayer; stay alert in it with thanksgiving. (Colossians 4: 2 CSB)

- **Time In His Instructions**

²Like newborn infants, desire the pure milk of the word, so that by it you may grow up into your salvation, (1 Peter 2: 2 CSB)

- **Time With His People**

⁴²They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching, to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread, and to prayer. (Acts 2: 42 CSB)

(II Point) _____ From The Guide.

⁹and be found in him, not having a righteousness of my own from the law, but one that is through faith in Christ—the righteousness from God based on faith. (Philippians 3: 9 CSB)

²²The **righteousness of God** is through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe, since there is no distinction. ²³For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God; ²⁴they are **justified** freely by his **grace** through the **redemption** that is in Christ Jesus. (Romans 3: 22-24 CSB)

(III Point) _____ The Guide.

¹⁰My **goal is to know him** and the power of his resurrection and the fellowship of his sufferings, being conformed to his **death**, ¹¹assuming that I will somehow reach the resurrection from among the dead. (Philippians 3: 10-11 CSB)

⁵Therefore, be imitators of God, as dearly loved children, ²and walk in love, as Christ also loved us and gave himself for us, a sacrificial and fragrant offering to God. (Ephesians 5: 1-2 CSB)

³This is how we know that we know him: if we keep his commands. ⁴The one who says, "I have come to know him," and yet doesn't keep his commands, is a liar, and the truth is not in him. ⁵But whoever keeps his word, truly in him the love of God is made complete. This is how we know we are in him: ⁶The one who says he remains in him should **walk just as he walked.** (I John 2: 3-6 CSB)
