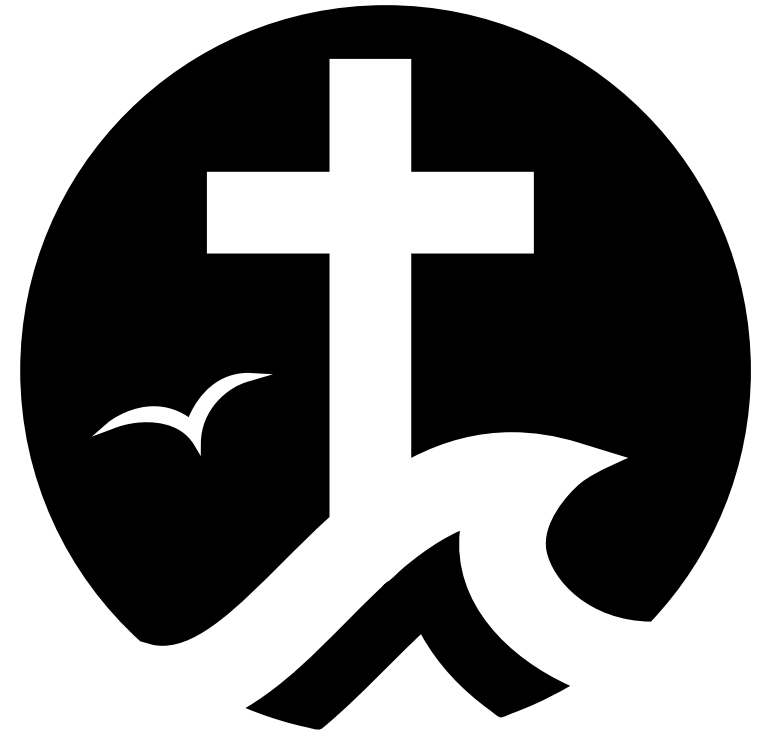

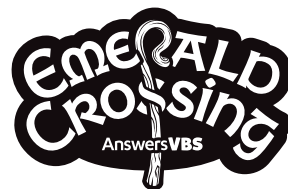

Philippians: Live Under The Authority of Christ

Part 3 Consider your Life in Christ

1. Consider your calling in Christ.

“If, then, there is any encouragement in Christ, if any consolation of love, if any fellowship with the Spirit, if any affection and mercy,² make my joy complete by thinking the same way, having the same love, united in spirit, intent on one purpose.” *Philippians 2:1-2 (CSB)*

⁹As the Father has loved me, I have also loved you. Remain in my love.¹⁰ If you keep my commands you will remain in my love, just as I have kept my Father’s commands and remain in his love.¹¹ “I have told you these things so that my joy may be in you and your joy may be complete.”¹² “This is my command: Love one another as I have loved you.¹³ No one has greater love than this: to lay down his life for his friends.¹⁴ You are my friends if you do what I command you.”
John 15:9-14 (CSB)

2. Consider the priority of caring for others in Christ.

³Do nothing out of selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility consider others as more important than yourselves.⁴ Everyone should look not to his own interests, but rather to the interests of others.”
Philippians 2:3-4 (CSB)

³⁵James and John, the sons of Zebedee, approached him and said, “Teacher, we want you to do whatever we ask you.”³⁶ “What do you want me to do for you?” he asked them.³⁷ They answered him, “Allow us to sit at your right and at your left in your glory. . . .”⁴¹ When the ten disciples heard this, they began to be indignant with James and John.⁴² Jesus called them over and said to them, “You know that those who are regarded as rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and those in high positions act as tyrants over them.⁴³ But it is not so among you. On the contrary, whoever wants to become great among you will be your servant.”⁴⁴ and whoever wants to be first among you will

be a slave to all.⁴⁵ For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.”

²³Let us hold on to the confession of our hope without wavering, since he who promised is faithful.²⁴ And let us consider one another in order to provoke love and good works,²⁵ not neglecting to gather together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging each other, and all the more as you see the day approaching.” *Hebrews 10:23-25 (CSB)*

3. Consider the confidence we have in Christ.

⁵Adopt the same attitude as that of Christ Jesus,⁶ who, existing in the form of God, did not consider equality with God as something to be exploited.⁷ Instead he emptied himself by assuming the form of a servant, taking on the likeness of humanity. And when he had come as a man,⁸ he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death—even to death on a cross.⁹ For this reason God highly exalted him and gave him the name that is above every name,¹⁰ so that at the name of Jesus every knee will bow—in heaven and on earth and under the earth—¹¹ and every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.”
