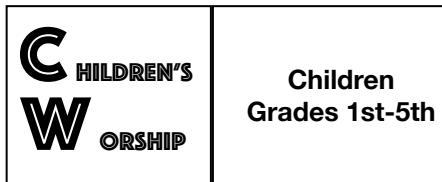

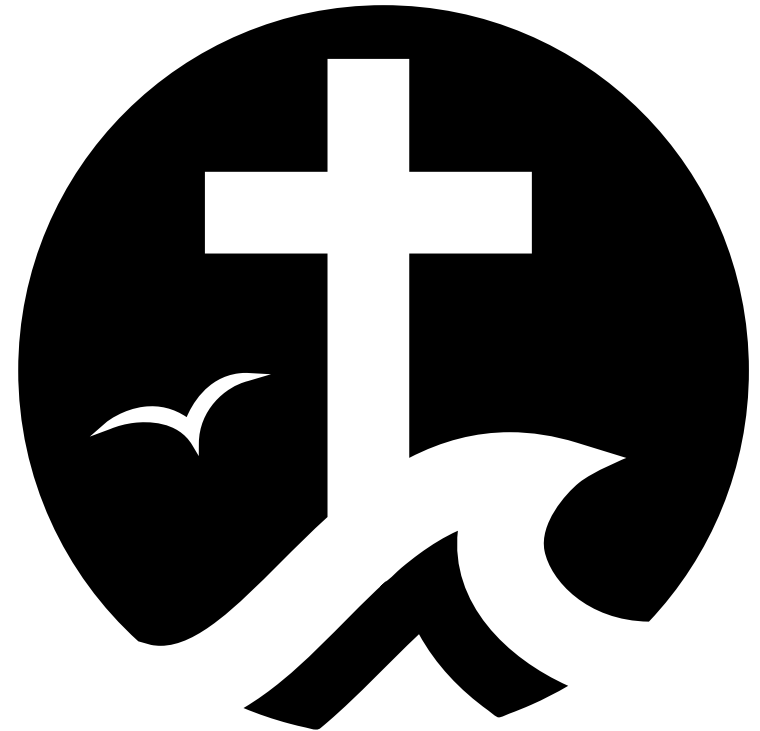

## Galatians: Live in The Truth of Jesus Christ

### Part 4

### Accept The Truth

#### 1. Accept The **Gospel** as **Truth** and Resist Satan's Lies.

"<sup>11</sup> But when Cephas (*Peter*) came to Antioch, I opposed him to his face because he stood condemned. <sup>12</sup> For he regularly ate with the Gentiles before certain men came from James. However, when they came, he withdrew and separated himself, because he feared those from the circumcision party. <sup>13</sup> Then the rest of the Jews joined his hypocrisy, so that even Barnabas was led astray by their hypocrisy. <sup>14</sup> But when I saw that they were deviating from the truth of the gospel, I told Cephas in front of everyone, "If you, who are a Jew, live like a Gentile and not like a Jew, how can you compel Gentiles to live like Jews?"

*Galatians 2:11-14 (CSB)*

"<sup>1</sup> Now the Spirit explicitly says that in later times some will depart from the faith, paying attention to deceitful spirits and the teachings of demons. <sup>2</sup> through the hypocrisy of liars whose consciences are seared. <sup>3</sup> They forbid marriage and demand abstinence from foods that God created to be received with gratitude by those who believe and know the truth."

*1 Timothy 4:1-3 (CSB)*

"<sup>12</sup> For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers of this darkness, against evil, spiritual forces in the heavens. <sup>13</sup> For this reason take up the full armor of God, so that you may be able to resist in the evil day, and having prepared everything, to take your stand. <sup>14</sup> Stand, therefore, with truth like a belt around your waist, righteousness like armor on your chest, <sup>15</sup> and your feet sandaled with readiness for the gospel of peace. <sup>16</sup> In every situation take up the shield of faith with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. <sup>17</sup> Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit—which is the word of God. <sup>18</sup> Pray at all times in the Spirit with every prayer and request, and stay alert with all perseverance and intercession for all the saints."

*Ephesians 6:12-18 (CSB)*

#### 2. Accept **Jesus Christ** as the only source of salvation.

"<sup>15</sup> We are Jews by birth and not "Gentile sinners," <sup>16</sup> and yet because we know that a person is not justified by the works of the law but by faith in Jesus Christ, even we ourselves have believed in Christ Jesus. This was so that we might be justified by faith in Christ and not by the works of the law, because by the works of the law no human being will be justified."

*Galatians 2:15-16 (CSB)*

"... through one trespass there is condemnation for everyone, so also through one righteous act there is justification leading to life for everyone. <sup>19</sup> For just as through one man's (*Adam's*) disobedience the many were made sinners, so also through the one man's (*Jesus*) obedience the many will be made righteous."

*Romans 5:18-19 (CSB)*

#### 3. Accept God's offer of the **new life** in Jesus Christ.

"<sup>17</sup> But if we ourselves are also found to be "sinners" while seeking to be justified by Christ, is Christ then a promoter of sin? Absolutely not! <sup>18</sup> If I rebuild those things that I tore down, I show myself to be a lawbreaker. <sup>19</sup> For through the law I died to the law, so that I might live for God. <sup>20</sup> I have been crucified with Christ, and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me. <sup>21</sup> I do not set aside the grace of God, for if righteousness comes through the law, then Christ died for nothing."

*Galatians 2:17-21 (CSB)*

"<sup>1</sup> And you were dead in your trespasses and sins <sup>2</sup> in which you previously walked according to the ways of this world, according to the ruler of the power of the air, the spirit now working in the disobedient. <sup>3</sup> We too all previously lived among them in our fleshly desires, carrying out the inclinations of our flesh and thoughts, and we were by nature children under wrath as the others were also. <sup>4</sup> But God, who is rich in mercy, because of his great love that he had for us, <sup>5</sup> made us alive with Christ even though we were dead in trespasses. You are saved by grace!"
