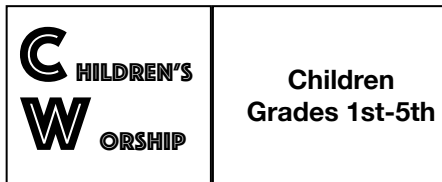

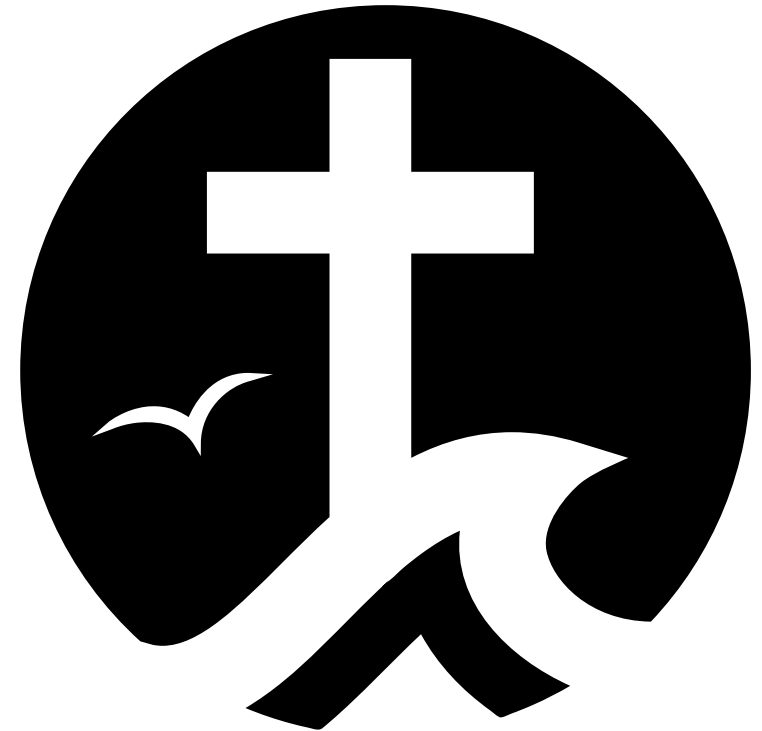

Our True Worship = A Living Sacrifice

¹² Therefore, brothers and sisters, in view of the mercies of God, I urge you to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God; this is your true worship. (Romans 12:1 CSB)

(I Point) Worship God Because of _____

¹² Therefore, brothers and sisters, in view of the mercies of God... (Romans 12:1 CSB)

¹⁰ For if, while we were enemies, we were reconciled to God through the death of his Son, then how much more, having been reconciled, will we be saved by his life. ¹¹ And not only that, but we also boast in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received this reconciliation. (Romans 5: 10-11 CSB)

¹² Therefore, Jesus also suffered outside the gate, so that he might sanctify the people by his own blood. ¹³ Let us, then, go to him outside the camp, bearing his disgrace. ¹⁴ For we do not have an enduring city here; instead, we seek the one to come. ¹⁵ Therefore, through him let us continually offer up to God a sacrifice of praise, that is, the fruit of lips that confess his name. (Hebrews 12: 13-15 CSB)

(II Point) Worship God by _____

¹² ... I urge you to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, (Romans 12:1 CSB)

²³ Then he said to them all, "If anyone wants to follow after me, let him deny himself, **take up his cross daily,** and follow me.

²⁴ For whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses

his life because of me will save it. ²⁵ For what does it benefit someone if he gains the whole world, and yet loses or forfeits himself? (Luke 9: 23-25)

²² But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness, and self-control. The law is not against such things. ²⁴ Now those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. ²⁵ **If we live by the Spirit, let us also keep in step with the Spirit.** ²⁶ Let us not become conceited, provoking one another, envying one another. (Galatians 5: 22-26 CSB)

(III Point) Worship God by _____

¹² ... holy and pleasing to God; this is your true worship. (Romans 12:1 CSB)

² Serve the Lord with gladness; come before him with joyful songs. ³ Acknowledge that the Lord is God. He made us, and we are his—his people, the sheep of his pasture. (Psalm 100: 2-3 CSB)

²⁴ "No one can serve two masters, since either he will hate one and love the other, or he will be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and money. (Matthew 6:24 CSB)

⁹ But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his possession, so that you may proclaim the praises of the one who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light. ¹⁰ Once you were not a people, but now you are God's people; you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy. (1 Peter 2: 9-10 CSB)
