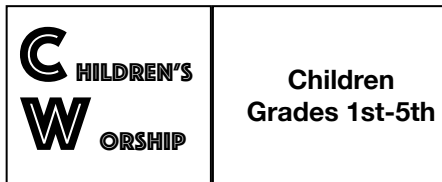

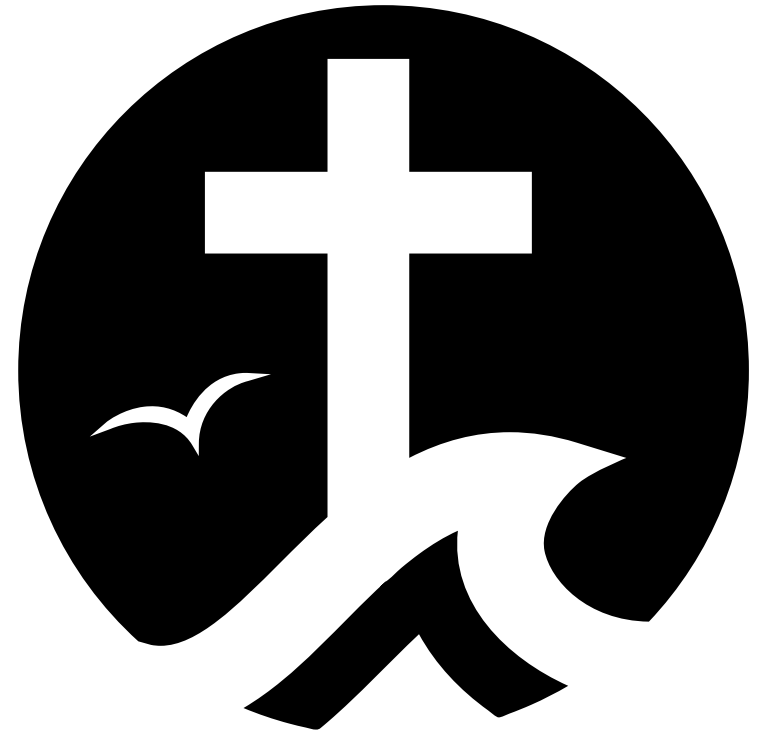

Part 2 *Servants of Christ*

1. As servants of Christ, we submit our will to God.

¹⁰For am I now trying to persuade people, or God? Or am I striving to please people? If I were still trying to please people, I would not be a servant of Christ.

⁴¹Then he (*Jesus*) withdrew from them about a stone's throw, knelt down, and began to pray, ⁴²"Father, if you are willing, take this cup away from me—nevertheless, not my will, but yours, be done."

¹⁷But so that this does not spread any further among the people, let's threaten them against speaking to anyone in this name again."

¹⁸So they called for them and ordered them not to speak or teach at all in the name of Jesus. ¹⁹Peter and John answered them, "Whether it's right in the sight of God for us to listen to you rather than to God, you decide; ²⁰for we are unable to stop speaking about what we have seen and heard."

2. As servants of Christ, we surrender our way to God.

¹¹For I want you to know, brothers and sisters, that the gospel preached by me is not of human origin. ¹²For I did not receive it from a human source and I was not taught it, but it came by a revelation of Jesus Christ. ¹³For you have heard about my former way of life in Judaism: I intensely persecuted God's church and tried to destroy it.

¹⁴I advanced in Judaism beyond many contemporaries among my

people, because I was extremely zealous for the traditions of my ancestors. ¹⁵But when God, who from my mother's womb set me apart and called me by his grace, was pleased ¹⁶to reveal his Son in me, so that I could preach him among the Gentiles, I did not immediately consult with anyone."

¹⁷Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has passed away, and see, the new has come! ¹⁸Everything is from God, who has reconciled us to himself through Christ and has given us the ministry of reconciliation. ¹⁹That is, in Christ, God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and he has committed the message of reconciliation to us."

2 Corinthians 5:17-19 (CSB)

3. As servants of Christ, we seek our work from God.

¹⁷I did not go up to Jerusalem to those who had become apostles before me; instead I went to Arabia and came back to Damascus. ¹⁸Then after three years I did go up to Jerusalem to get to know Cephas, and I stayed with him fifteen days. ¹⁹But I didn't see any of the other apostles except James, the Lord's brother. ²⁰I declare in the sight of God: I am not lying in what I write to you. ²¹Afterward, I went to the regions of Syria and Cilicia. ²²I remained personally unknown to the Judean churches that are in Christ. ²³They simply kept hearing, "He who formerly persecuted us now preaches the faith he once tried to destroy." ²⁴And they glorified God because of me."

²⁰Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, since God is making his appeal through us. We plead on Christ's behalf, "Be reconciled to God." ²¹He made the one who did not know sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God."
