Molly drives six hours from the city, then faces a rugged hike on foot to reach that valley. That's only in warm weather. In winter, nobody can get there.

Just one family of Christians live in the valley. The family has been the local contact for Molly and other ministry partners who have been helping get a supply of clean water set up for the valley.

A real victory came last year when Molly traveled with a woman living in the city to and from the valley. After many hours of teaching, the woman made a profession of faith in Christ!
