WHY IS THE GREATEST - LOVE?

- It's what I long for
- It's what I need to change my life
- It's what I can pass on to others to leave a legacy

I am not to be a <u>container</u> of God's love...but a <u>conduit</u> of love.

"If I give everything I own to the poor and even go to the stake to be burned as a martyr, but I don't love, I've gotten nowhere. So, no matter what I say, what I believe, and what I do, **I'm bankrupt without love."** (1 Corinthians 13:3 MSG)

"Dear brothers and sisters, what's the use of saying you have faith if you don't prove it by your actions?" (James 2:14 NLT)

"So now I am giving you a new commandment: **Love each other**. Just as I have loved you, you should love each other. Your love for one another will prove to the world that you are My disciples." (John 13:34-35 NLT)

TO DEEPEN MY LOVE...

I must replace my desire for <u>convenience</u> - ...with <u>obedience</u> to God's ways.

"You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind. This is the first and greatest commandment. A second is equally important: Love your neighbor as yourself." (Matthew 22:37-39 NLT)

"Love never gives up. Love cares more for others than for self. Love doesn't want what it doesn't have. Love doesn't strut, Doesn't have a swelled head, Doesn't force itself on others, Isn't always 'me first,' Doesn't fly off the handle, Doesn't keep score of the sins of others, Doesn't revel when others grovel, Takes pleasure in the flowering of truth, Puts up with anything, Trusts God always, Always looks for the best, Never looks back, But keeps going to the end. Love never dies." (1 Corinthians 13:4-8 MSG)

"[Jesus said] If you love Me, obey My commandments." (John 14:15 NLT)

"Loving God means keeping His commandments, and really, that isn't difficult." (1 John 5:3 NLT)

I must <u>soak-in</u> God's love -...and constantly be <u>filled-up</u>.

• God's love is personal

"I am the good shepherd; I know My own sheep..." (John 10:14 NLT)

• God's love is transforming

"If anyone belongs to Christ, there is a new creation. The old things have gone; everything is made new!" (2 Corinthians 5:17 NCV)

• God's love is sacrificial
