

HOW TO BUILD A FRIENDSHIP WITH GOD

It's Not You, It's Me - Pt 4

"Draw close to God, and God will draw close to you." (James 4:8a NLT)

"We were restored to <u>friendship with God</u> by the death of his Son while we were still his enemies, so we will certainly be delivered from eternal punishment by his life. NOW we can rejoice in our wonderful <u>new relationship with God</u>—all because of what our Lord Jesus Christ has done for us in <u>making us friends of God!</u>" (Romans 5:10-11 NLT)

Jesus: "I no longer call you servants... Instead, I call you my <u>friends!</u>" (John 15:15)

". . . He is a God who is <u>passionate</u> about his relationship with you." (Exodus 34:14 NLT)

GOD: "I don't want your sacrifices—I want <u>your love</u>; I don't want your offerings—I want you to <u>know me!</u>" (Hosea 6:6 LB)

"Starting from scratch, God made the entire human race and made the earth hospitable, with plenty of time and space for living <u>so that we could seek after God</u>, and not just grope around in the dark but actually find him!" (Acts 17:26-27 MSG)

1. MAKE KNOWING GOD MY #1 PRIORITY.

"Everything else is worthless compared with the priceless gain of <u>knowing Christ</u> <u>Jesus</u>. I've discarded everything else, counting it all as garbage, so that I may know Christ." (Philippians 3:8 NLT)

"You will find me when you seek me with ALL your heart." (Jeremiah 29:13)

2. SLOW DOWN AND BE QUIET.

"Be still and know that I am God." (Psalms 46:10a NIV)

"Friendship with the Lord is reserved for those who reverence him. With them he shares the secrets of his covenant." (Psalm 25:14)

"When you come before God, don't turn it into a theatrical production . . . Just find a quiet, secluded place so you won't be tempted to role-play before God. <u>Just be there as simply and honestly as you can manage</u>. The focus will shift from you to God, and you will begin to sense his grace." (Matthew 6:5-6 MSG)

3. <u>DECIDE WHOSE FRIENDSHIP YOU WANT THE MOST.</u>

"You should know that loving the world is the same as hating God. Anyone who wants to be a friend of the 'world' becomes an enemy of God." (James 4:4 NCV)

Jesus: "You are my <u>friends</u> if you obey me." (John 15:14 NLT)

4. MAINTAIN A CONSTANT CONVERSATION.

"Pray all the time!" (1 Thessalonians 5:17)

"My determined purpose is that I may know Him—that I may progressively become more deeply and intimately acquainted with Him, perceiving and recognizing and understanding the wonders of His Person more strongly and more clearly." (Philippians 3:10 AMP)

5. TRUST GOD IN YOUR PLAN.

"Cast all your cares on the Lord and he <u>will</u> sustain you; he will never let the righteous fall." (Psalm 55:22)

In Trouble?

"I'll <u>get you out of your trouble</u>. And I'll give you the best of care if you'll only get to know and trust me." (Psalm 91:14 MSG)

Drifted Away From God?

"If you return to me, I <u>will restore you</u> so you can continue to serve me. If you speak words that are worthy, you will be my spokesman. You are to influence them; do not let them influence you!" (Jeremiah 15:19 NLT)

"No one shows greater love than when he <u>lays down his life for his friends</u>. <u>And you are my friends</u> IF you do what I command." (John 15:13-14)

"And this is what God commands: <u>that we believe in his Son</u>, Jesus Christ, and that we love each other, just as he commanded." (1 John 3:23 NCV)
