The book of Judges is a narrative of Israel's history that took place

- BETWEEN the time they moved **into** the Promised Land under Joshua –
- And about 330 years later when Israel became a monarchy with King Saul.

The Cycle of Israel:

- They would disobey God's Law -
- And it would result in disaster.
- And then they would cry out for help -
- And God would send them a deliverer.

Don't get too judgmental with the people in the book of Judges – this is **OUR STORY!**

"I'm going to do – what I think – is right."

- You do what YOU think is right.
- And don't tell me what's right because:
 - What's right for YOU –
 - May NOT BE what's right for ME!

Judges 19

(v. 1) "Now a LEVITE who lived in a remote area in the hill country of Ephraim – took a concubine from Bethlehem in Judah.

(v. 23) The owner of the house went outside and said to them, 'No my friends, don't be so vile. Since this man is my guest, don't do this outrageous thing.

(v. 24) Look, here is my virgin daughter, and his concubine. I will bring them out to you now, and you can use them and do to them whatever you wish...'

(v. 25) But the men would not listen to him. So the man (the Levite) took his concubine and sent her outside to them...

(v. 30) Everyone who saw it was saying to one another, 'Such a thing has never been seen or done, not since the day the Israelites came up out of Egypt. Just imagine! We must do something! So speak up!!!'" Final verse in the book of Judges - Judges 21:25

"In those days – Israel had no king; and EVERYONE DID – WHAT WAS RIGHT – IN THEIR OWN EYES."
