Grit: strength of character that refuses to quit

- When I commit I don't quit!
- ⁵ Don't be afraid of suffering for the Lord. Work at telling others the Good News, and **fully carry out the ministry God has given you**.
- ⁶ As for me, my life has already been poured out as an offering to God. The time of my death is near.
- ⁷ I have fought the good fight, <u>I have finished the race</u>, and I have remained faithful. (2 Timothy 4:5-7 NLT)

I know your deeds; you have a reputation of being alive, but you are dead. Wake up! Strengthen what remains and is about to die, for I have found your deeds <u>unfinished in</u> the sight of my God. (Revelation 3:1-2 NIV)

What is your unfinished business?					

Here is my advice: It would be good for you to finish what you started a year ago. Last year you were the first who wanted to give, and you were the first to begin doing it. **Now you should finish what you started**. (2 Corinthians 8:10-11 NLT)
