

WHY IS LIFE SO HARD? At War – Pt 1 Pastor Craig Coulter

Faith doesn't spare us from all pain!
Some of God's promises will be fulfilled in eternity!
We are runners in a – "*historical relay race*!"

THEREFORE, since we are surrounded by such a huge crowd of witnesses to the life of faith, let us <u>strip off every weight</u> that slows us down, <u>especially the sin</u> that so easily <u>hinders our progress</u>. And <u>let us run with endurance</u> the race that God has set before us. We do this <u>by keeping our eyes on Jesus</u>, on whom our faith depends from start to finish. He was willing to die a shameful death on the cross <u>because of</u> <u>the joy he knew would be his afterward</u>. Now he is seated in the place of highest honor beside God's throne in heaven. <u>Think about all he endured</u> when sinful people did such terrible things to him, <u>so that you don't become weary</u> and give <u>up</u>. After all, you have not yet given your lives in your struggle against sin! (Hebrews 12:1-4 NLT)

1. Remember – <u>HEAVEN IS WATCHING ME</u>.

THEREFORE, since we are surrounded by such a huge crowd of witnesses to the life of faith... (Hebrews 12:1a)

2. I must - ELIMINATE WHAT DOESN'T MATTER.

...let us <u>strip off every weight</u> that slows us down, <u>especially the sin</u> that so easily <u>hinders our progress</u>... (Hebrews 12:1b)

3. Run - GOD'S RACE FOR ME.

And let us run with endurance the race that God has set before us. (Hebrews 12:1c)

4. Focus - ON JESUS - NOT MY CIRCUMSTANCES.

We do this <u>by keeping our eyes on Jesus</u>, on whom our faith depends from start to finish. (Hebrews 12:2a)

5. Minimize - THE PAIN AND MAXIMIZE THE PROFIT.

He was willing to die a shameful death on the cross <u>because of the joy he knew</u> would be his AFTERWARD. NOW he is seated in the place of <u>highest honor</u> beside God's throne in heaven! (Hebrews 12:2b)

Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest IF we do not give up. (Galatians 6:9 NIV)

6. Think about - WHAT GOD DID FOR ME.

<u>Think about all he endured</u> when sinful people did such terrible things to him, <u>so</u> <u>that you don't become weary and give up</u>. After all, you have not yet given your lives in your struggle against sin! (Hebrews 12:3-4)

What have I started that I need to finish?

Finish what you started a year ago... for you were the first to begin doing something about it! Now you should carry this project <u>through to completion just</u> <u>as enthusiastically</u> as you began it. <u>Give whatever you</u> can <u>according to what</u> <u>you have</u>! (2 Corinthians 8:10-11 NLT)

Don't throw it all away now. You were sure of yourselves then. It's still a sure thing! But you need to stick it out, staying with God's plan so you'll be there for the promised completion. (Hebrews 10:35-36 MSG)
