WHY DO I HOLD ON TO SELF-DEFEATING HABITS?

- 1. BECAUSE I've had them for so long.
- 2. BECAUSE I identify with them.
- 3. BECAUSE my defects have a payoff.
- **4.** BECAUSE <u>Satan discourages me</u>.

²¹Since you have heard all about Jesus and have <u>learned the truth that is in Him</u>, ²²throw off your old evil nature and <u>your former way</u> of life, which is rotten through and through, full of lust and deception. ²³Instead, there must be a <u>spiritual renewal of your thoughts and attitudes</u>. ²⁴You must <u>put on your new nature</u> because you are a <u>new person</u>, created in God's likeness—righteous, holy, and true. ²⁵So put away all falsehood and <u>tell your neighbor the truth</u> because we belong to each other. ²⁶Don't let the sun go down while you are still angry, ²⁷for anger gives a mighty foothold to the devil. (Ephesians 4:21-27 NLT)

SIX REQUIREMENTS FOR LASTING CHANGE:

1. CHANGE REQUIRES LEARNING THE TRUTH

Since you have heard all about Jesus and have <u>learned the truth that is in Him</u>... (Ephesians 4:21)

All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful to <u>teach us what is true</u> and to make us <u>realize what is wrong</u> in our lives. It <u>straightens us out</u> and <u>teaches us to do what is right</u>. It is God's way of preparing us in every way, fully equipped for every good thing God wants us to do. (2 Timothy 3:16-17 NLT)

2. CHANGE REQUIRES MAKING CHOICES

...<u>throw off</u> your old evil nature and your former way of life, which is rotten through and through, full of lust and deception. (Ephesians 4:22)

... Continue to <u>WORK OUT</u> your salvation with fear and trembling, for it is God who <u>WORKS IN you</u> to <u>will</u> and to <u>act</u> according to his <u>good purpose</u>. (Philippians 2:12-13)

3. CHANGE REQUIRES NEW THINKING

Instead, there must be <u>a spiritual renewal</u> of <u>your thoughts and attitudes</u>. (Ephesians 4:23)

Let the same <u>mind and attitude</u> be in you which was in Christ Jesus. (Philippians 2:5 AMP)

4. CHANGE REQUIRES THE HOLY SPIRIT

You must <u>put on your new nature</u> because you are a <u>new person</u>, created in God's likeness—righteous, holy, and true. (Ephesians 4:24)

As the Spirit of the Lord works within us, we become more and more <u>like Him</u>. (1 Corinthians 3:18 LB)

5. CHANGE REQUIRES HONEST COMMUNITY

So put away all falsehood and <u>tell your neighbor the</u> truth because <u>we belong to each other</u>. (Ephesians 4:25)

By helping each other with your troubles, you truly obey the law of Christ. (Galatians 6:2 NCV)

6. CHANGE REQUIRES OVERCOMING TEMPTATION

Don't let the sun go down while you are still angry, for anger gives a <u>mighty foothold</u> to the devil. (Ephesians 4:26-27)
