### • BY KEEPING CONFIDENCES

<u>No one who gossips can be trusted</u>...but you can put your confidence in someone who is trustworthy. (Proverbs 11:13 TEV)

# 3. LISTEN WITH EMPATHY

Be <u>quick to listen</u>, slow to speak, and slow to get angry. (James 1:19)

We must bear the burden of being considerate of the doubts and fears of others... (Romans 15:2a LB)

# 4. ACCEPT THEIR FAULTS

Accept each other just as Christ has accepted you; then God will be glorified. (Romans 15:7 NLT)

# 5. <u>CELEBRATE WINS & SHARE LOSSES</u>
