### 1. AWESOME FAMILIES ARE PLAYFUL

Solomon: I commend the enjoyment of life... (Ecclesiastes 8:15 NIV)

People ought to <u>enjoy every day</u> of their lives, no matter how long they live. (Ecclesiastes 11:8a NCV)

Enjoy life with your wife, whom you love... (Ecclesiastes 9:9 NIV)

Children are a gift from God. (Psalm 127:3 LB)

I recommend having fun... That way you will experience some happiness along with all the hard work God gives you. (Ecclesiastes 8:15 NLT)

#### 2. AWESOME FAMILIES **ENCOURAGE GROWTH**

Jesus grew in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and with man. (Luke 2:52 NIV)

#### WHAT DO WE LEARN FROM OUR FAMILIES?

- What to do with feelings

#### HOW?

#### • THROUGH **EXAMPLE**

Jesus: Since I have washed your feet, you ought to wash each other's feet. I <u>have given you an</u> <u>example to follow. Do as I have done to you.</u> (John 13:14-15 NLT)

## • THROUGH **CONVERSATONS**

You must <u>teach</u> God's commandments to your children and <u>talk about them</u> when you are <u>at home</u> or <u>out for a walk</u>; at <u>bedtime</u> and the <u>first thing in the morning</u>. (Deuteronomy 6:7 LB)

# NOT THROUGH <u>CRITICIZING</u>

Don't keep on <u>scolding and nagging</u> your children, making them angry and resentful. Instead bring them up with the loving training and teaching of the Lord. (Ephesians 6:4)

## NOT THROUGH <u>COMPARING</u>

Each person should judge his own actions and not compare himself with others. Then he can be proud for what he himself has done. (Galatians 6:4 NCV)

## 3. AWESOME FAMILIES PROTECT EACH OTHER

Two are better than one... If one of them <u>falls down</u>, the other can help him up. But if someone is alone and falls, it's just too bad, because there is no one to help him. (Ecclesiastes 4:9-10 GN)
