### TO LOVE LIKE JESUS I MUST ...

## 1. CARE FOR MY OWN FAMILY

- Pays attention

## 2. TREAT OTHER BELIEVERS AS MY FAMILY

Whenever we have the opportunity to help anyone, we should do it. But we should give special attention to those who belong to the family of believers. (Galatians 6:10 NCV)

Share each other's troubles and problems, and in this way obey the law of Christ. (Galatians 6:2 NLT)

## 3. LEARN TO SEE OTHER'S PAIN EVEN WHEN I'M IN PAIN

Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus. (Philippians 2:5 NIV)

Since Christ suffered and underwent pain, you must have the same attitude he did; you must be ready to suffer, too. For remember, when your body suffers, sin loses its power. (1 Peter 4:1 TLB)

# 4. MEET OTHER'S NEEDS EVEN IF MINE AREN'T MET

Each one of us needs to look after the good of the people around us, asking ourselves, "How can I help?" (Romans 15:2 MSG)

When God's children are in need, be the one to help them out. Get into the habit of inviting guests home for dinner or, if they need lodging, for the night. (Romans 12:13 TLB)
