#### We make our DECISIONS, and then our DECISIONS make us.

WHEN FACED WITH \_\_\_\_\_ (situation),

- I am FAITHFUL.
- I am CONSISTENT.
- I am READY.
- I am GENEROUS.
- I am a FINISHER.

## We lose the battle with <u>TEMPTATION</u>,

## Because we aren't prepared or <u>READY</u> to face it.

Be on your guard; stand firm in the faith; be courageous; be strong. (1 Corinthians 16:13)

Watch and pray <u>so that you will not fall into temptation</u>. The spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak. (Matthew 26:41)

## WHY ARE WE ON GUARD?

## 1. The <u>DEVIL</u> is coming for you.

I wrote for this purpose: to test your character to see if you are obedient in everything. Anyone you forgive, I do too. For what I have forgiven – if I have forgiven anything – it is for your benefit in the presence of Christ, so that we may not be taken advantage of by Satan. For we are not ignorant of his schemes. (2 Corinthians 2:9-11)

2. You are not as <u>STRONG</u> as you think.

So, if you think you are standing firm, be careful that you don't fall! (1 Corinthians 10:12)

# Restraint Bias: The tendency to <u>OVERESTIMATE</u> our ability to resist temptations when making a decision. This leads to <u>MORE</u> exposure to said temptation.

# HOW TO WIN THE FIGHT AGAINST TEMPTATION

## 1. You have to move the <u>LINE</u>.

The boundary lines have fallen for me in pleasant places; indeed, I have a beautiful inheritance. (Psalms 16:6)

## 2. Magnify the <u>COST</u>.

## Question you <u>must</u> ask yourself:

## WHAT IF THE WORST-CASE SCENARIO COMES TRUE?

...you have sinned against the Lord; and be sure that your sin will find you out. (Numbers 32:23)

## 3. Plan your <u>ESCAPE</u>.

...Joseph was a very handsome and well-built young man, and Potiphar's wife soon began to look at him lustfully. "Come and sleep with me," she demanded. (Genesis 39:6-7)

## DON'T USE YOUR DISAPPOINTMENT TO JUSTIFY YOUR DISOBEDIENCE.

She grabbed him by his garment and said, "Sleep with me!" But leaving his garments in her hand, he escaped and ran outside. (Genesis 39:12)

No temptation has come upon you except what is common to humanity. But God is faithful; he will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation he will also provide a way out so that you may be able to bear it. (1 Corinthians 10:13)
