

COME TO THE PARTY!

Mercy – Part 5 Luke 19 Pastor Craig Coulter

<u>Jesus saved us,</u> not because of the good things we did, **but <u>BECAUSE OF HIS MERCY</u>**. He washed away our sins and gave us **a new life** through the Holy Spirit. (Titus 3:5)

Jesus: "I have come to **SEEK** and to **SAVE** those who are **LOST**." (Luke 19:10)

Jesus told 3 stories to explain what he meant:

- The Lost Sheep (Luke 15:1-7)
- The Lost Coin (Luke 15:8-10)
- The Lost Son (Luke 15:11-31)

'LOSTNESS' - implies value

WHAT HAPPENS WHEN I'M LOST?

Like a lost sheep . . .

1. I LOSE MY DIRECTION.

All of us have <u>strayed away</u> just like lost sheep. We've all left God's path to follow our own ways. (Isaiah 53:6)

Like a lost coin . . .

2. I LOSE MY POTENTIAL.

No one has ever seen or heard or even imagined the wonderful things God has prepared and arranged for those who love him. (1 Corinthians 2:9)

Like a lost son . . .

3. I LOSE MY HAPPINESS.

The younger son wasted all he'd been given and eventually he became <u>miserable</u> and lonely. (Luke 15:14)

BUT I DON'T LOSE - MY VALUE!

HOW DO I CONNECT WITH GOD'S MERCY?

1. I GET <u>FED UP</u> WITH MY LIFE.

... he wasted it all ... he had nothing left ... he got <u>desperate and hungry</u> ... then he <u>finally came to his senses</u> ... (Luke 15:13-17)

GOD: "You'll find me <u>when you get serious</u> about finding me and <u>want it more</u> than anything else." (Jeremiah 29:13 MSG)

2. I OWN UP TO MY SIN.

When he <u>came to his senses</u>, he said . . . "<u>I have sinned</u> against God and you . . ." (Luke 15:17-18)

3. I OFFER UP MYSELF.

The son drifted away saying, "GIVE ME MY share . . . " (Luke 15:12)

He returned to the Father saying, "MAKE ME a servant." (Luke 15:19)

THE FATHER'S RESPONSE:

While he was <u>still a long way off</u>, his father <u>saw him</u> and was <u>filled with compassion</u> <u>for him</u>; HE RAN OUT to his son, threw his arms around him, and kissed him. (Luke 15:20)

YOU ARE WORTH THIS MUCH:

God <u>loved the world so much</u> that He gave His one and only Son so that whoever believes in Him <u>may not be lost</u>, but have eternal life. (John 3:16)
