

HOPE: When You Really Need A Miracle - Pt 4

LUKE 5:1-11

One day as Jesus was standing by the Lake of Gennesaret, with the people crowding around him and listening to the word of God, he saw at the water's edge two boats, left there by the fishermen, who were washing their nets. <u>He got into one of the boats</u>, the one belonging to Simon, and asked him to put out a little from shore. Then he sat down and taught the people from the boats. (vs. 1-3)

When he had finished speaking, he said to Simon, "Now launch out into deep water, and let down the nets for a catch." Simon answered, "Master, <u>we've worked hard</u> <u>all night and haven't caught anything</u>." (vs. 4-5a)

WHAT DO YOU DO WHEN YOU COME UP EMPTY?

1. GIVE JESUS <u>COMPLETE ACCESS TO MY LIFE</u>.

Jesus <u>got into one of the boats</u>, the one belonging to Simon, and asked him to put out a little from shore. Then he sat down and taught the people from the boat. (vs. 3)

2. ADMIT THAT MY EFFORTS ARE NOT WORKING.

When Jesus had finished speaking, he said to Simon, "Now launch out into deep water, and let down the nets for a catch." Simon answered, "Master, <u>we've worked</u> <u>hard all night</u> and <u>haven't caught anything</u>." (vs. 4-5a)

3. OBEY WHATEVER JESUS TELLS ME TO DO.

Simon answered, "Master, we've worked hard all night and haven't caught anything. **<u>BUT BECAUSE YOU SAY SO</u>**, **<u>I will</u>** let down the nets." (vs. 5)

4. EXPECT JESUS TO TURN THINGS AROUND.

The One who calls you is completely dependable. If he said it, he'll do it! (1 Thessalonians 5:24 MSG)

When they had done so, they <u>caught such a large number</u> of fish that their nets began to break! So they <u>signaled their partners</u> in the other boat to come and help them, and they came and <u>filled both boats</u> so full that they began to sink! (vs. 6-7)

PETER'S REACTION

When Simon Peter saw this, <u>he fell at Jesus' knees</u> and said, "Go away from me, Lord; <u>I am a sinful man</u>!" For he and all his companions were <u>astonished</u> at the catch of fish they had taken, and so were James and John, the sons of Zebedee, Simon's partners. (vs. 8-9)

THE REAL LESSON

Then Jesus said to Simon, "Don't be afraid; from now on you will catch men." So they pulled their boats up on shore, <u>left everything and followed him</u>. (vs. 10-11)
