

WHAT TO DO - WHEN IT FEELS HOPELESS

SEVEN STEPS FROM JONAH 2:1-10

1.WHEN YOU HIT BOTTOM, LOOK UP!

From inside the fish Jonah prayed to the Lord his God. (Jonah 2:1)

2. PRAY <u>PASSIONATELY!</u>

Jonah said, "In my distress and deep trouble I <u>CRIED OUT</u> to the Lord and he answered me." (Jonah 2:2)

3. IDENTIFY THE CAUSE OF MY HOPELESSNESS!

"You cast me into the <u>deep water</u>, and I <u>sank to the bottom</u> of the sea. <u>Everything was churning</u> <u>around me</u>, and I was <u>engulfed by powerful waves that overwhelmed me</u>. Then I thought 'I've been <u>banished from God's presence</u>, and I'll never <u>get to see your holy temple</u> again.' I was <u>scared to</u> <u>death</u>; <u>afraid</u> I was drowning with water <u>choking me</u> and seaweed wrapped all around my head. I kept sinking down to mountains that rise off the ocean floor. I felt <u>locked in a prison forever</u>..." (Jonah 2:3-6)

8 CAUSES OF HOPELESSNESS

CHECK any that you may be feeling

FEELING I'M IN OVER MY HEAD

"You cast me into the DEEP water."

FEELING <u>I'VE HIT BOTTOM</u>

"I sank to the bottom of the sea."

FEELING OUT OF CONTROL & POWERLESS

"Everything was churning around me."

FEELING OVERWHELMED

"I was engulfed by powerful waves that overwhelmed me."

FEELING <u>REJECTED OR LONELY</u>

"Then I thought 'I've been banished from God's Presence.""

FEELING <u>REMORSE & REGRET</u>

"...and I'll never get to see your holy temple again."

FEELING CRUSHING FEAR

"I was <u>scared to death</u>, <u>afraid</u> I was drowning with water choking me and seaweed wrapped all around my head."

FEELING TRAPPED

"I felt locked in a prison forever."

4. ASK GOD FOR <u>SPECIFIC HELP</u>!

"From the deep in the world of the dead <u>I ASKED FOR HELP</u> and you listened to my cry." (Jonah 2:2b)

Call to me in your times of trouble. I will save you, and you will honor me. (Psalm 50:15 NCV)

5. FOCUS ON THE <u>GOODNESS</u> OF GOD.

"When I had LOST ALL HOPE, I turned my thoughts once more to the Lord." (Jonah 2:7 NLT)

6. REJECT FALSE FIXES & ACCEPT GOD'S GRACE.

"Those who look to worthless idols forfeit the grace that could be theirs." (Jonah 2:8)

"You, O Lord, <u>saved me</u> and brought my life back up from the pit." (Jonah 2:6b)

7. EXPRESS GRATITUDE TO GOD IN ADVANCE.

"I will <u>sing a song of thanksgiving</u>, ...and I will <u>sacrifice to you</u>, ...and I will <u>do what I have promised you to do</u> ...because salvation comes from the Lord!" (Jonah 2:9)

- THROUGH <u>SINGING</u>
- THROUGH GIVING BACK TO GOD
- THROUGH <u>RECOMMITTING TO MY MISSION</u>

For God's gifts and His call are irrevocable. (Romans 11:29 NIV)

So, the Lord ordered the great fish to vomit Jonah onto a beach. (Jonah 2:10)
