You obsess about what others <u>THINK</u> .	
You are often overly <u>SENSITIVE</u> .	
You compromise your <u>VALUES</u> .	
You hesitate in sharing your <u>FAITH</u> .	
You have a hard time <u>SAYING NO</u> .	

BECOMING OBSESSED WITH WHAT PEOPLE THINK ABOUT YOU, IS THE QUICKEST WAY TO FORGET WHAT GOD THINKS ABOUT YOU.

 Pleasing people is a form of <u>IDOLATRY</u> ... It's putting the opinion of people ahead of the opinion of God.

2 SIMPLE STEPS TO GET OVER THE DISEASE TO PLEASE

1. FOCUS ON <u>PLEASING</u> GOD INSTEAD OF <u>PLEASING</u> PEOPLE.

Obviously, I'm not trying to win the approval of people, but of God. If pleasing people were my goal, I would not be Christ's servant. (Galatians 1:10)

2. LIVE <u>FROM</u> THE APPROVAL OF GOD INSTEAD OF <u>FOR</u> THE APPROVAL OF PEOPLE.

For we speak as messengers approved by God to be entrusted with the Good News. Our purpose is to please God, not people. He alone examines the motives of our hearts. (1 Thessalonians 2:4)
