This is Derek Prince with a word for you from the Word.

*I will praise the LORD, who counsels me; even
at night my heart instructs me.* NIV

Oh, it's so good to know that you have access to the counsel of the Lord when you've come to the end of your own ability, when you've reasoned everything out and it doesn't make sense. When you're at an impasse in your life and you don't know which way to turn.

Remember, the Lord is the wonderful counselor. Go to Him, commit it to Him and in His own wonderful way He will show you the answer.
