Psalm 33:6, 9

This is Derek Prince with a word for you from the Word.

By the word of the LORD were the heavens made, their starry host by the breath of his mouth. For he spoke and it came to be; he commanded, and it stood firm. NIV

Ever since human history began men have speculated as to the origin of the universe in which we live. What is the first cause? How did it all come into being?
