- 1. Jesus loves us and he didn't deny his works nor his divinity to save his own life (Mark 14:55-62).
- 2. Jesus could have saved himself but he chose to suffer because of his amazing love for us (Mark 14:63-65).
- 3. We should never let fear prevent us from living a righteous life during adversities because Jesus knows our heart (Mark 14:66-67).
- 4. You must not deny the truth about your relationship with Jesus Christ because he loves you (Mark 14:68-69).
- 5. Jesus' love is always available regardless of the number of times you deny the truth. (Mark 14:70-71).
- 6. We must acknowledge the truth and it will set us free from the guilt that's holding us in bondage (Mark 14:72).
- 7. Jesus wants personal time with you regardless of your flaws or sinful nature because of his amazing love for you (John 21:15).
- 8. We must not allow guilt to hold us in bondage because Jesus amazing love is with us (John 21:16-17).
- 9. We must always remember we are susceptible to various challenges in life as servants of Jesus Christ but Jesus love will sustain us (John 21:18-19).

Intelligence: Jesus used his intelligence to relate to the disciples and others. He loves us but dislike our sinful ways, but Jesus gives us an option to be a servant for his glory.

Neglect: Jesus will never neglect the spiritual needs of others because of his steadfast love for people to get to know him.

Grace: Jesus knows you better than you know yourself and his grace is always available through his amazing love for you.
