Questions for Sunday, January 18th, 2025

- 2- How does the statistic that 80% of people cite hypocrisy as their reason for rejecting Christianity challenge you personally in how you live out your faith in everyday interactions?
- 3- What practical steps can local churches take to maintain unity with other Bible-believing churches while still preserving their distinct denominational values and traditions?
- 4- How does understanding the Holy Spirit as our 'coach' rather than following human leadership change the way we should approach decision-making and direction in the church?
- 5- If you were asked by a non-Christian neighbor why you attend church, how would you respond in a way that addresses common negative perceptions while sharing the gospel?
- 6- Why is it essential for the church to function 'as one team' rather than in competition with other churches, and how can individual believers promote this unity in practical ways?
- 7- How does the 'one hope' of confident assurance in salvation through Christ alone provide the foundation for the church's message to a world searching for meaning and purpose?

- 8- If the Holy Spirit's mission is to glorify Jesus, how should this shape our corporate worship, preaching, and ministry priorities as a church?
