Questions for Sunday, May 3rd, 2026

2- In what ways might you be tempted to justify poor work ethic or cutting corners when you feel your boss or company is treating you unfairly, and how does Ephesians 6:5-9 challenge this thinking?

3- What does it mean practically to work 'as if you were serving the Lord, not people' when your boss or coworkers are not believers and may not share your values?

4- How does the concept of Jesus making himself a bondservant in Philippians 2:5-8 reshape our understanding of authority, service, and humility in workplace relationships?

5- If your coworkers were asked to describe what kind of person your work ethic and attitude reveal, would their description align with the character of Christ?

6- How might God be using your current workplace, even if it is not your ideal job, as a mission field to represent Him to those around you?

7- What specific changes would you need to make in your work habits, attitude, or interactions if you truly believed God was observing and evaluating your daily performance?
