Questions for Sunday, May 10, 2026

How does recognizing that spiritual warfare targets specific areas like marriage, family, and workplace change the way you approach challenges in those relationships?

Why do you think 52% of Canadians do not believe Satan is active in the world today, and how might this disbelief make people more vulnerable to spiritual attack?

In what ways have you experienced deception, accusation, or lies in your spiritual life without recognizing them as attacks from the evil one?

Jesus told Peter 'Get behind me, Satan' when Peter tried to prevent Jesus from going to the cross. Can you identify a time when well-meaning people or your own thoughts were actually hindering God's plan for your life?

What does it reveal about our human nature that we often try to fight spiritual battles with our own plans and strength rather than relying on God's armor?

The belt of truth holds all other pieces of armor together. What happens in our lives when we compromise on biblical truth in favor of cultural acceptance or personal preference?

How does understanding that your righteousness comes from Christ rather than your behavior change the way you respond to guilt, shame, or feelings of unworthiness?

If the Word of God is our only tangible weapon against spiritual attack, what does your current Bible reading and study habit reveal about how prepared you are for battle?
