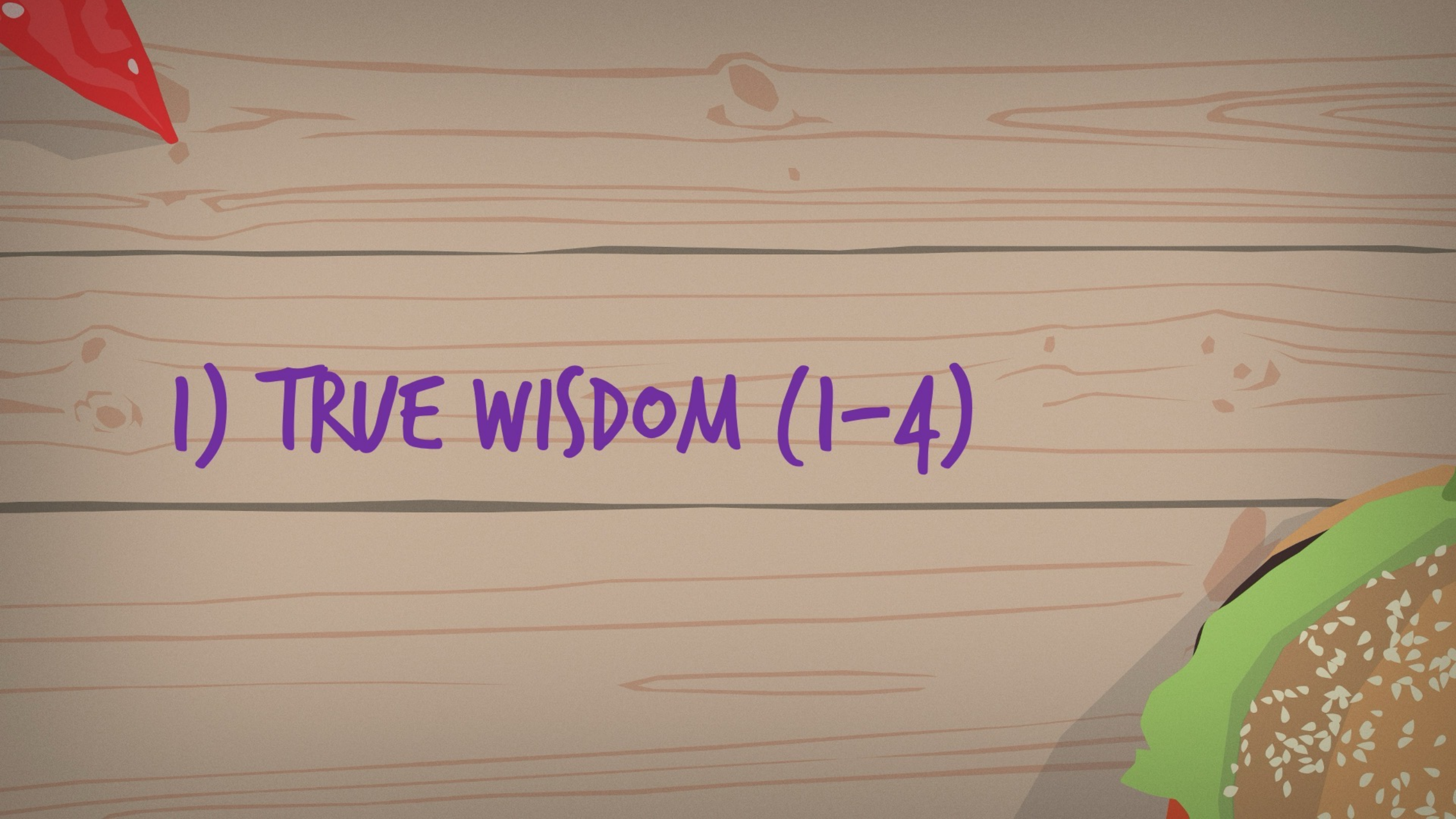

my heart's meditation brings understanding.

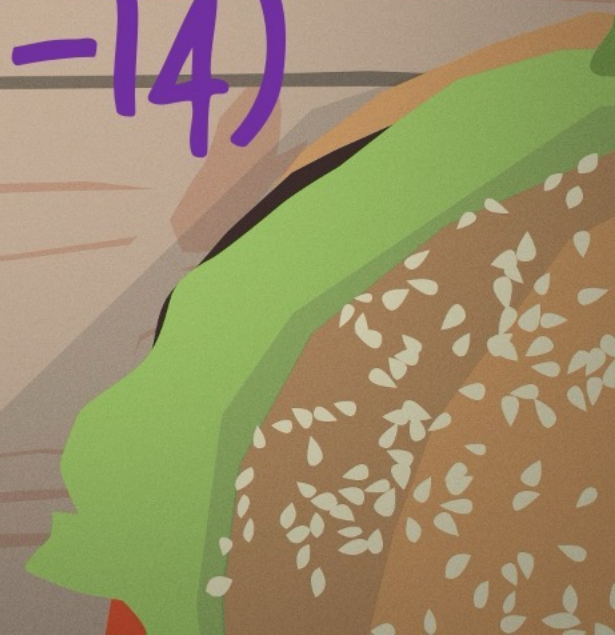
⁴I turn my ear to a proverb;

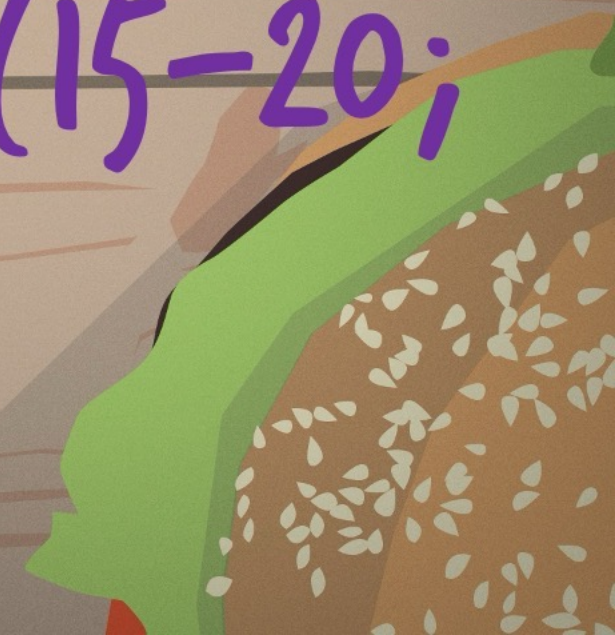
