

#### <sup>8</sup>Deacons, likewise...

Whoever wants to become great among you will be your *deacon*, and whoever wants to be first among you will be a slave to all. For even the Son of Man did not come to be *deaconed*, but to *deacon*, and to give his life as a ransom for many."

Mark 10:43-45

### 1) DEACONS, SERVANTS, MINISTERS 2) A FAITHFUL DEACON IS...



<sup>8</sup>Deacons, likewise, should be worthy of respect, not hypocritical, not drinking a lot of wine, not greedy for money, <sup>9</sup>holding the mystery of the faith with a clear conscience. <sup>10</sup>They must also be tested first; if they prove blameless, then they can serve as deacons.

<sup>11</sup>Wives, likewise, should be worthy of respect, not slanderers, self-controlled, faithful in everything. <sup>12</sup>Deacons are to be husbands of one wife, managing their children and their own households competently. 13 For those who have served well as deacons acquire a good standing for themselves and great boldness in the faith that is in Christ Jesus.

- (1) The women who are part of the general order of deacons
- (2) They are female deacons or deaconesses who correspond somehow to the male deacons
- (3) They are "assistants to deacons" like the praiseworthy widows (1 Tim 5:9–10) and older women who train the younger (Titus 2:3–5)
- (4) They are the deacons' wives




In those days when the number of disciples was increasing, the Hellenistic Jews among them complained against the Hebraic Jews because their widows were being overlooked in the daily distribution of food. So the Twelve gathered all the disciples together and said, "It would not be right for us to neglect the ministry of the word of God in order to wait on tables. Brothers and sisters, choose seven men from among you who are known to be full of the Spirit and wisdom. We will turn this responsibility over to them and will give our attention to prayer and the ministry of the word."

This proposal pleased the whole group. They chose Stephen, a man full of faith and of the Holy Spirit; also Philip, Procorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas, and Nicolas from Antioch, a convert to Judaism. They presented these men to the apostles, who prayed and laid their hands on them.

So the word of God spread. The number of disciples in Jerusalem increased rapidly, and a large number of priests became obedient to the faith.
