## Vs. 13

You are the salt of the earth- If you have wondered what you are as a believer here it is. If you profess to follow Jesus, you are the salt of the earth.

Disciples are like salt because they are precious. - Guzik

The Gospel preserves life. Likewise salt preserves as well.

**Trampled underfoot by men-** It should be noted that there is some salt that is only good for being thrown down to prevent people from slipping.

Just as salt preserves, light illuminates and exposes.

# Vs. 14

You are the light of the world- Believers are instruments in how God shines His light in this world.

If we receive the light of Christ, we must also give the light of Christ.

We cannot only live to ourselves, we must have someone to shine to, and do so lovingly. -Guzik

A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden- The idea is that a believers we are visible. We are set apart. We can be identified.

The Christian life is something very high and sublime, to which we cannot arrive without pains: while it withdraws us from the earth, and carries us nearer heaven, it places us in view, and as a mark, to the malice of carnal men. - Quesnel (The Christian Treasury)

Christ never contemplated the production of secret Christians, Christians whose virtues would never be displayed, pilgrims who would travel to heaven by night, and never be seen by their fellow pilgrims or anyone else. - Spurgeon

If you are a follower of Christ then you have to ask the question of how is your light on display.

### Vs. 15

On a lamp stand- The idea is this light would be put up high for all to see.

**Gives light to all-** As followers of Christ we are a responsibility to give this light out.

Thus let every follower of Christ, and especially every preacher of the Gospel, diffuse light of heavenly knowledge, and the warmth of Divine love through the whole circle of their acquaintance. - Clarke

# Vs. 16

Let your light so shine before men- This is not a suggestion, this is a command.

Jesus never challenged us to become salt or light. He simply said that we are salt and light. - Guzik

We will never shine our light in our world by being like the world.

**That they may see-** The purpose of our lives is to bring glory to God. To reflect the grace of the Father.

In order to walk in the light, you have to walk by the light.

God is said to be glorified, when the glorious power of His grace is manifested in the salvation of men. - Clarke
