Scripture: Luke 10:38-42

Date: 01/14/2018 Bible Version: NKJV

BOTTOM LINE: The Gospel is counterintuitive. Slowing down in Christ yields more than speeding up or doing it on your own.

Vs. 38

A certain village - The village was Bethany and it was located less than two miles from Jerusalem.

Martha welcomed Him- Martha received Jesus as a guest.

Vs. 39

Had a sister called Mary - Martha had a sister named Mary. She also had a brother named Lazarus. This is the Lazarus that Jesus raised from the dead.

Sat at Jesus' feet - Notice what Mary was doing. She was sitting at the feet of Jesus.

This was the posture of the Jewish scholars, while listening to the instructions of the rabbi's.- Adam Clarke

Heard His word - As a result of sitting at the feet of Jesus, Mary heard His words.

Vs. 40

Martha was distracted- She was busy, so busy that the things that she was working on had to stop because there was another thing that was just as important vying for her attention.

with much serving - Martha was busy with serving others. She no doubt knew how to take care of others. She had undeniable one of the greatest guests she could ever have.

Therefor tell her to help me - Martha was bugged with the fact that Mary was sitting and not helping.

Martha is busy but not blessed. She's busy and she's bitter.- Jon Courson

She let the task that was at hand distract her from the priority of being with Jesus.

You have an assignment from God and it's your job to protect against busyness. Busyness is not a spiritual gift.

Vs. 41

You are worried and troubled about many things - Jesus could see that Martha was carrying a heavy burden. Martha was so worried about getting things ready for this occasion that she forgot who was at this occasion.

Vs. 42

But one thing is needed - Jesus points to the one thing that is needed. That one thing is time and attention to our savior.

Likewise, many of us are so busy that we can't see what God has before us.

Three things you can do now to detox.

1. Slow down.

Our greatest weakness flows out of our greatest strength.- Peter Scazzero

[Psa 46:10 NLT] "Be still, and know that I am God! I will be honored by every nation. I will be honored throughout the world."

2. Anchor yourself in God's love

[Eph 3:17 NLT] Then Christ will make his home in your hearts as you trust in him. Your roots will grow down into God's love and keep you strong. [Eph 3:18 NLT] And may you have the power to understand, as all God's people should, how wide, how long, how high, and how deep his love is.



3. Understand the gift of God (break loose from the things that are less than God).

[Mat 11:28 NLT] Then Jesus said, "Come to me, all of you who are weary and carry heavy burdens, and I will give you rest.

[Mat 11:30 NLT] For my yoke is easy to bear, and the burden I give you is light."
