Our church board met this past Monday and here are a few of the highlights:

Church Officers and Upcoming Elections

In March 2020, our church held elections for church officers who were to serve from March 2020-March 2021. COVID hit in March 2020 which greatly impacted how and what were able to do in the church over the past year. In effect, our elected officers have not been able to serve in the "normal" capacity during this past year.
