MAIN IDEA: GOD'S IMMUTABILITY MEANS HE NEVER CHANGES

I, the Lord, do not change. Malachi 3:6a

THREE THINGS ABOUT GOD THAT NEVER CHANGE

I. GOD'S LOVE FOR ME NEVER CHANGES.

...I have loved you with an everlasting love... Jeremiah 31:3

Your love never changes, so save me! Psalm119:159b (GN)

REMEMBER THIS: I NEVER NEED TO DOUBT GOD'S LOVE

... (nothing) will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord. Romans 8:38

II. GOD'S WORD NEVER CHANGES

The grass withers, the flowers fade, but the Word of our God shall stand forever. Isaiah 40:8 (LB)

Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will never pass away. Matthew 24:35

Long ago I learned from Your statutes that You established them to last forever. Psalm 119:152
