Who Is backcountry.church? - FAQs

1. Is backcountry.church a "real" church.

- a. YES. On two levels. First, we are registered in the State of California as a legal church.
- b. On a biblical level, we need to ask the basic question: what is a biblical church. This is addressed in Part 2 of the series, who is backcountry.church. Here is the link. We took a step back and asked this very question. As a result, we put in place the basic practices of the early church.

2. Are there any other churches doing what we are doing?

a. The very word "church" in our language refers to a building where people meet. As an example: "Where did you go this weekend? I went to church." Churches have as their center point an addresses or location. Because that is not what church is, backcountry.church is not our practice. We are not aware of others doing what backcountry.church does.

a. Yes. We encourage everyone to explore our website and use our tools to connect with God.

4. How is this different than a Facebook group?

a. Facebook Groups are amazing. While backcountry.church may have Facebook Groups, it is a tool that helps us accomplish the second part of our mission statement (connecting with others). A Facebook Group is not an *ecclesia*. It can be a tool of the *ecclesia*.

5. Will you ever meet in person?

- a. Yes! Connections to each other should occur all over the US. In fact, over the course of time, I will be in various places throughout the US and would love to meet you, maybe do a hike with you, maybe have a small group or prayer and Bible study time.
- b. You can do this with others in BCC where you are! Don't wait for the "professional"

- b. I do not take a salary from bbc. In fact, as of this recording, everyone who is engaged serves voluntarily. So the funds received go to making BCC happen and towards those in need website costs, video production, advertising.
- c. We will occasionally partner with non-profits that are doing missions work that we can support through our network of believers.
