MAIN IDEA: THE COUNSELOR I CHOOSE INFLUENCES LIFE'S DIRECTION

pele' (peh'-leh): beyond understanding, too wonderful for words.

ya'ats (yaw-ats'): to advise; to consult, to guide.

HEALING WITH THE WONDERFUL COUNSELOR

1) BE BRUTALLY HONEST WITH THE COUNSELOR.

(Jesus) told her, Go, call your husband and come back. I have no husband, she replied. John 4:16-17

2) LISTEN TO THE COUNSELOR'S VOICE.

...a voice came from the cloud: This is my Son, whom I love. Listen to him! Mark 9:7

3) DO WHAT THE COUNSELOR TELLS YOU TO DO.

Teacher, he declared, all these I have kept since I was a boy. Jesus looked at him and loved him. Mark 10:20-21a
