#### I. Leviticus

- A. Written by Moses while they were at Sinai
- B. Teaching was regulatory and revelatory
- C. Purpose
  - 1. To show Israel how to live as God's people
  - 2. To install an awareness of sin and describe what constitutes Holiness
  - 3. To foreshadow the complete and perfect sacrifice of Christ
  - 4. To add to the revelation of God's nature by focusing on Holiness

#### II Holiness

- A. God is HOLY, HOLY, HOLY it is His EESSENCE
  - a. I Chronicles 16: 29; Isaiah 6:3
- B. The word Holiness comes from Wholeness
- C. Leviticus 20: 26
- D. Obedience is the Pathway to Holiness-Jerry Bridges
- E. Sanctification- growing in Holiness
- F. God is more concerned about your Holiness than your Happiness

### III Sacrifices

- A. Sacrifices declare the wages of sin is death. Romans 6:23
- B. Sacrifices were prescribed by God to teach holiness, worship, atonement, and responsibility. They foreshadow Jesus.

### IV Priesthood CH 8 and 10

- A. The Tribe of Levi were Priest, Aaron was the High Priest
- B. Lord consumed the sacrifices Lev 9: 22-25
- C. Death of Aaron's sons-

When you minimize sin you minimize God's Holiness

- D. Believers in Jesus Christ are Priests 1 Peter 2: 5, 9
- E. Old Testament God's people **had** a priesthood but in the New Testament Gods' people **are** the priesthood. Jesus is our High Priest.
- V Cleanliness and Godliness CH 11-15
  - A. God's standard for holy living- define holy v. unholy; clean v. unclean
  - B. Spiritual principle of separateness and being set apart still applies today
