## Truths from Genesis:

- Blessing: Everything we need for life and service (Creation)
- Where there is sin, there is death. (the Fall)
- When we minimize sin, we minimize God's holiness. (the Flood)
- God's discipline enables his obedience. (the beginning of nations / tower of Babel)
- God's blessing comes through his design and in his time. (Genesis)
- Our salvation is by faith not works (Abraham – Genesis 12)
- Obedience grows your faith (Genesis 12:1-3)
- We have a great high priest, Jesus Christ, who mediates and intercedes for us. (Melchizedek)
- While you are waiting, God is working. (Genesis 13-14, Abrahamic Covenant)
- Never be afraid to trust and unknown future to a known God (Genesis 15, Abrahamic Covenant Ceremony)
- Spiritual maturity is about perseverance in faith. (circumcision, Genesis 16-18)
  - Our sin is always a result of doubting an attribute of God.
  - The joys of faith must become greater than the comforts of this life.
- Testing provides opportunity for prompt obedience- prompt and sustained obedience (Abraham and Isaac – the sacrifice, Genesis 22)
- Victory comes through Surrender (Jacob wrestles with God, Genesis 32)
- God is always with us and is in control (Joseph, Genesis 37-50)
