## MANNA

We looked at manna a couple of weeks ago, so we all know that God provided it as food for the Israelites. I laughed when I read that the word manna is spoken in Hebrew it sounds like "What is it?" in English. That's exactly what the Jewish people thought when they saw it. It was called "bread from heaven". In John 6:32, Jesus refers to Himself as "the true bread from heaven." Christ is the true manna and sufficient

to meet the needs of all people	Philippians 4:29

to strengthen believers for service	Philippians 4:16
sustain them in that service	1 Corinthians 10:13

### AARON'S ROD

Aaron's rod that budded is also in the ark. We will actually look at this a little deeper in Numbers, but basically the people were challenging Moses and Aaron's right to lead. Some terrible stuff happens and God instructs Moses to choose one representative from each of the 12 tribes and have them bring an almond branch. All of the branches are placed before the testimony and the next morning, only Aaron's rod had budded, blossomed, and yielded almonds.

This branch is a picture of Christ's resurrection. And look at how it not only moved from death to life, it produced fruit. The Bible teaches us that Christ is the first fruit in 1 Corinthians 15:23 and he wants us to bear fruit as well.

### TEN WORDS

The final item in the ark were the ten commandments, or ten words. The law. These are not the broken tablets, but the ones that we considered last week. The new tablets. Christ's life and ministry were in definite fulfillment of the law.
