INTRODUCTION

Welcome to Church 101!

We're glad you've chosen to find out more about Wapakoneta Community Worship Center! This class is the basic introduction to our church family. Since we have attenders from many different church backgrounds, this class was designed to clearly explain who we are and what we believe.

OUR STORY

Founded by Alta Culpepper and Rosemary Shultzin 1955. Meeting first in a local home, then moving to a store in the downtown area. They held street meetings on Saturday nights in front of the downtown bank. In 1956 they purchased the former St. Marks Lutheran Church giving Maranatha Assembly of God their own building. Miss Culpepper and Miss Shultz led the congregation until 1958.

From 1958 to 2007 multiple Pastors led the church. In 2007 Pastor Dan Holbrook became the Lead Pastor and led the congregation for the next 10 years. During this time the church purchased the land, and built the facility at its present location. In 2017, Pastor Dan accepted a position with the Ohio Ministry Network.

In August of 2018 Pastor Jason Goss accepted the call to lead the congregation.

Basic Habit One: Bible Study & Prayer

2 Timothy 3:16 All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful to teach us what is true and to make us realize what is wrong in our lives. It corrects us when we are wrong and teaches us to do what is right. **17** God uses it to prepare and equip his people to do every good work. *(NLT)*

A vibrant relationship with God is sustained through Bible study and prayer.

HOW DO I GET MORE FROM MY BIBLE?

We believe that the Holy Bible, and only the Bible, is the authoritative Word of God. It alone is the final authority in determining all doctrinal truths. In its original writing, it is inspired, infallible and inerrant.

* _____ God's Word with an open heart.

Luke 8:13 The seeds on the rocky soil represent those who hear the message and receive it with joy. But since they don't have deep roots, they believe for a while, then they fall away when they face temptation. 14 The seeds that fell among the thorns represent those who hear the message, but all too quickly the message is crowded out by the cares and riches and pleasures of this life. And so they never grow into maturity. 15 And the seeds that fell on the good soil represent honest, good-hearted people who hear God's word, cling to it, and patiently produce a huge harvest. 16 "No one lights a lamp and then covers it with a bowl or hides it under a bed. A lamp is placed on a stand, where its light can be seen by all who enter the house. 17 For all that is secret will eventually be brought into the open, and everything that is concealed will be brought to light and made known to all. 18 "So pay attention to how you hear. To those who listen to my teaching, more understanding will be given. But for those who are not listening, even what they think they understand will be taken away from them." (NLT)

Basic Habit Three: Living a Spirit-Led Life

Having close relationships with other people is only part of God's plan for our lives. He desires to be our most intimate friend.

THE HOLY SPIRIT'S ROLE IN OUR LIVES

Acts 1:4 Once when he was eating with them, he commanded them, "Do not leave Jerusalem until the Father sends you the gift he promised, as I told you before. **5** John baptized with water, but in just a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit." **6** So when the apostles were with Jesus, they kept asking him, "Lord, has the time come for you to free Israel and restore our kingdom?" **7** He replied, "The Father alone has the authority to set those dates and times, and they are not for you to know. **8** But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. And you will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere—in Jerusalem, throughout Judea, in Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." (*NLT*)

1. The Holy Spirit enables us to know God's:

John 14:16 And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate, who will never leave you. (*NLT*)

John 16:5 "But now I am going away to the one who sent me, and not one of you is asking where I am going 6 Instead, you grieve because of what I've told you. 7 But in fact, it is best for you that I go away, because if I don't, the Advocate won't come. If I do go away, then I will send him to you. 8 And when he comes, he will convict the world of its sin, and of God's righteousness, and of the coming judgment. (*NLT*)

2. The Holy Spirit empowers us to live with Christ-like:

Galatians 5:22 But the Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, **23** gentleness, and self-control. There is no law against these things! (*NLT*)

Acts 1:8 But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. And you will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere—in Jerusalem, throughout Judea, in Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." (*NLT*)

3. The Holy Spirit equips us with:

² Corinthians 3:17 For the Lord is the Spirit, and wherever the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. **18** So all of us who have had that veil removed can see and reflect the glory of the Lord. And the Lord—who is the Spirit—makes us more and more like him as we are changed into his glorious image. (*NLT*)

1 Corinthians 12:4 There are different kinds of spiritual gifts, but the same Spirit is the source of them all... **7** A spiritual gift is given to each of us so we can help each other. **8** To one person the Spirit gives the ability to give wise advice; to another the same Spirit gives a message of special knowledge. **9** The same Spirit gives great faith to another, and to someone else the one Spirit gives the gift of healing. **10** He gives one person the power to perform miracles, and another the ability to prophesy. He gives someone else the ability to speak in unknown languages, while another spirit. Still another person is given the ability to speak in unknown languages, while another is given the ability to interpret what is being said. **11** It is the one and only Spirit who distributes all these gifts. He alone decides which gift each person should have. (*NLT*)

Acts 2:17 'In the last days,' God says, 'I will pour out my Spirit upon all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy. Your young men will see visions, and your old men will dream dreams. 18 ...even on my servants—men and women alike—and they will prophesy... 21 ... everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.' (*NLT*)

Spiritual gifts often lead to titles or positions but a person may have the gift without the role or the role without the gift. Regardless, we should serve whenever we are given the opportunity. Working in the area of your gifting will allow you to "be" the person that God has called you to be rather than just "doing" good things.
