

Bible study for the week starting November 16, 2025

Did you learn stewardship/giving at a young age from your parents? From someone else? Have you learned it yet at all? When you think of a good, faithful steward, who comes to mind?

READ/STUDY/DISCUSS

- 1. Read Malachi 3:6-10. This is a classic stewardship Scripture reading, though not the main reading for this message. God owns everything; why does He still say we're "robbing" Him when we do not give offerings? We are literally called not to put God to the test, but here He makes an exception and says, "Test me and see." Why?
- 2. Read 2 Corinthians 9:6-15 (throw in 8:1-15). These are great concepts: growing in the grace of giving, cheerful giving, exceling in giving even out of poverty. What else sticks out about these passages?
- 3. Read Luke 21:1-4. This widow gave a couple small coins, and her example has been used by Jesus for 2,000 years! What is the point of Jesus singling her out?
- 4. Read Luke 16:10-14 (and the parable of the dishonest manager before it, if you dare). What is the lesson for us, and why does Jesus talk so much about money, based on 16:4?

PRAY

Pray for the faith to trust that God will provide and to commit to the rare spiritual fruit of growing in the grace of giving.
