

Bible study for the week starting August 15, 2021 Parables of Jesus: Humbled and Exalted

SHARE

1. It's the start of a new school year. What's your best "back to school" memory?

READ/STUDY/DISCUSS

- 2. Read Psalm 34:1-15. David says, "I will bless the Lord at all times." Read the heading to the Psalm (and feel free to look up the story in 1 Samuel 21). When David says "all times," he really means it. Knowing that, read this Psalm and soak in the depth of what David is praying.
- 3. Read I Peter 5:1-II, especially about the humility in verses 5-6. What kind of perspective does these verses give you in the battles you're experiencing? What is the adversary doing? What is God doing?
- 4. Read Luke 14:1-11. Jesus is at dinner on the Sabbath (quite a memoriable one at that!). What's the "big picture" of what is guiding Jesus when so many other religious leaders are getting lost in the weeds of legalism?
- 5. Can you think of a time you needed to be humbled and something happened to do just that? What emotions did you feel when you were "put in your place?" Can you think of a time you were flat on your face in humility or humiliation and you were lifted up? What emotions did you feel when you were helped to your feet?

PRAY FOR AND WITH ONE ANOTHER

6. Share what's going on in your lives and pray for these joys and needs.
