SHARE

 In the face of persecution and death, Stephen chose to forgive. How has forgiveness shaped your life? Relationships? Who has forgiven you? Who have you forgiven? Who has withheld forgiveness? Who have you withheld forgiveness from?

READ/STUDY/DISCUSS

- 1. Read Acts 7:54-8:1a.
- 2. Why did they gnash their teeth? What were they mad about? (read v. 51-53 for reminder)
 - a. Does God's word bring you comfort or confrontation more often?
 - b. When confronted: Do you respond with repentance or rejection? When?
- 3. Think about what Stephen saw when he was nearing his death? (v.55-56) Have you ever heard of other near death experiences and visions? What do you think about those?
 - a. What do you think? Is Jesus standing in Judgement or Respect? Both?
- 4. Read Luke 23:32-46- comapre and contrast the death of Jesus and Stephen's death.
- 5. What would you want your last words to be? Read Luke 17:1-6

6. Pray: That our lives, even up to our death reflect Jesus. Pray for forgiveness to reign in our hearts. Pray for the persecuted church around the world. Look up persecution.com for present info.

Two ways to respond when confronted with God's Word

-<u>REPENTANCE.</u>

-REJECTION.
