READ/STUDY/DISCUSS


- 1. Read 1 John 2:5-17 What sticks out? What detail strikes you in a way it maybe hasn't before?
 - a. What do you find to be the hardest part of this challegne from John?
 - b. How do you love the world...but keep from loving the world?
 - c. He defines the world as the "desires of the flesh, and eyes and the pride of life." How does your life battle these desires?

2. Read John 15:12-21

- a. "If the world hates you..." Hate them back? JK. How do you love those that hate you? Does this word from Jesus bring comfort or disturbance?
- 3. Read 1 John 4:18 and John 16:33. What do these verses do to the fear that we may have when facing the world?

Pray for the world in which we live. For the brokeness and those that are far from the Lord and opportunities to engage culture with the Gospel!
