



Bible study for the week starting July 6, 2025

SHARE

We've covered a lot of ground in the book of Revelation. What's something that sticks out in your memory? After everyone gets a chance to share something, consider what these things tell us about God. How has this given you a new insight or confirmed what you already believed?

READ/STUDY/DISCUSS

1. Read **Revelation 14:1-5**. John is describing an earthly band ready to go to battle. Compare and contrast the tone of this passage of scripture with that of the last two chapters? What surprises you about the description here?
2. The 144,000 are called virgins. How does this connect with the language of **Exodus 34:10-16**? How about **Deuteronomy 6:4-5**?
3. Revelation describes this virgin host as "these who follow the Lamb wherever he goes." Read **Ruth 1:6-18** and **John 1:43-51**. What attributes do you see in these passages that would apply to the host that follows the Lamb?
4. Share ways in which you have been called (as part of the church militant) to follow the Lamb wherever he goes. What have you found most challenging? What are some "helps" that you've used to overcome these challenges?
5. Extra credit. **2 Chronicles 20:13-23** describes the God's response to King Jehoshaphat's prayer for deliverance from invading armies. How does this, along with our Revelation passage inform your understanding of the use of singing as part of the Christian walk?

Pray for each other's needs. Then close with a song that everyone knows. Keeping eyes open is optional.

Where the Lamb goes, the gates of hell **COLLAPSE**.

Our role:

1. **GO** with Him (follow the Lamb).
2. **SING** the new song.
3. He draws us in to His work of **RENEWING** the whole earth.
