

Bible study for the week starting March 5, 2023

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
What's one place or thing on earth you'd love to see more than anything else? Is it a wonder of the world? Landmark? Monument? Something else? Why is this the #1 on your list?

READ/STUDY/DISCUSS

- Read Acts 19:21-41. This is the account of an epic showdown between Paul and his associates and the Ephesians and their goddess Artemis. This is a little different than the spiritual battle in the first half of Acts 19 (the infamous "Sons of Sceva" story – worth the review), but still a spiritual battle nonetheless. What are you learning from these showdowns about the battle between God and Satan over your own heart, soul, strength and mind?
- 2. Read Acts 20:1-16. I always knew Paul and the other apostles got to be a part of God's miracle working. The insight I've gotten during this time in the book of Acts is the connection between the apostles' ministry and Jesus' ministry, as one is the continuation of another. How do you see this playing out? How is this the same or different today?
- 3. Read **Malachi 3:1-7**. What's the purpose of God's refinement? God is both a judge and a deliverer. But He reminds us He does not change; based on verses 6-7, how is this good news for us?
- 4. Read Luke 7:18-28. What are the marks of Jesus' ministry that identify Him as the Messiah for John the Baptist? Who are the marks of the apostolic ministry in the first generation of the church that validate their ministry?

PRAY

5. Pray that in our own spiritual battles – big and small – God would be faithful in our lives and others'.
